Fr. John Kersten, Pastor of St. Jo-seph Church announced his retire-ment, Mar. 5, 1995, effective Sep. 24. Since no priest was available to take Fr. Kersten's place, a meeting was held Mar. 29, with Bishop Houck in attendance to listen to suggestions and ideas on how the two parishes could strengthen their relationship. It was the begin-ning of what we now call the Catholic Community of Meridian.
