



In the Spring of 1876 Father Luis Vally made a return visit to his native France. His family was surprised and delighted by his unexpected visit. He was warmly welcomed by them. While there, however, he was stricken with a severe fever and pneumonia. For a time the young priest feared that he would never again see his congregation in Meridian.
