

#### From The Archives

On June 1, 1911, Mount St. Joseph School held its first end of year closing exercise. Fr. Ten Brink delivered the first address and an account of the ceremony was published in the Meridian Star. In one short year, the enrollment in the school grew to 120 and five teachers were on the staff. The school & mission continue to grow. By the end of 1913, the mission membership had grown to 68 and the first wedding was celebrated.
