ASCENSION!

Today, we celebrate the Ascension of Jesus into heaven after completing His redemptive work here on earth. This great feast had always been celebrated on a Thursday (40 days after Easter), but this year, Cardinal Tobin, head of our Newark Archdiocese, joined most other dioceses in the United States in moving this solemnity to the nearest Sunday. In this way, many more Catholics are aware of this feast and can fully participate in its meaning!

As we know, Jesus appeared numerous times to His disciples after His Resurrection. His message was always one of PEACE and reassurance. After about forty days, Jesus invited His special followers to meet Him on a hillside. Just before leaving, Jesus gave the “Great Commission” to His disciples, (and to us), to go out to all the world and tell everyone the Good News of the Gospel message. Jesus did not come just for His close friends, nor just for the Jewish people, BUT for all people - all men and women, regardless of race or religion AND for all ages unending. The message was clear. Jesus is God and has redeemed everyone. No one is lost or alone, and this short life here on earth does have a powerful meaning – LOVE! For anyone willing to accept and live this message of love for God and others, there is guaranteed inner peace and everlasting life! Our God is SO good!!

However, as Jesus had prepared His friends times before, they and we need to know that this commission would never be an easy task! Jesus knew that they and we, needed extra help for this work in building up God’s Kingdom here on earth. Jesus plainly told them, and tells us, that we would not be alone. He would always be with them, and us! Moreover, they were to go back to the upper-room and wait for the Holy Spirit to come upon them. This Holy Spirit would give them and us, through Confirmation, special spiritual gifts to go out and to make a real difference in the world. The Holy Spirit would come upon the apostles at Pentecost and they would never be the same - nor are we, once we are confirmed!

Next week, here at Sacred Heart, Bishop Michael Saporito, auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Newark for Bergen County, will be with us at the 12:00 noon Mass to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation upon 23 of our eighth graders. They are:
