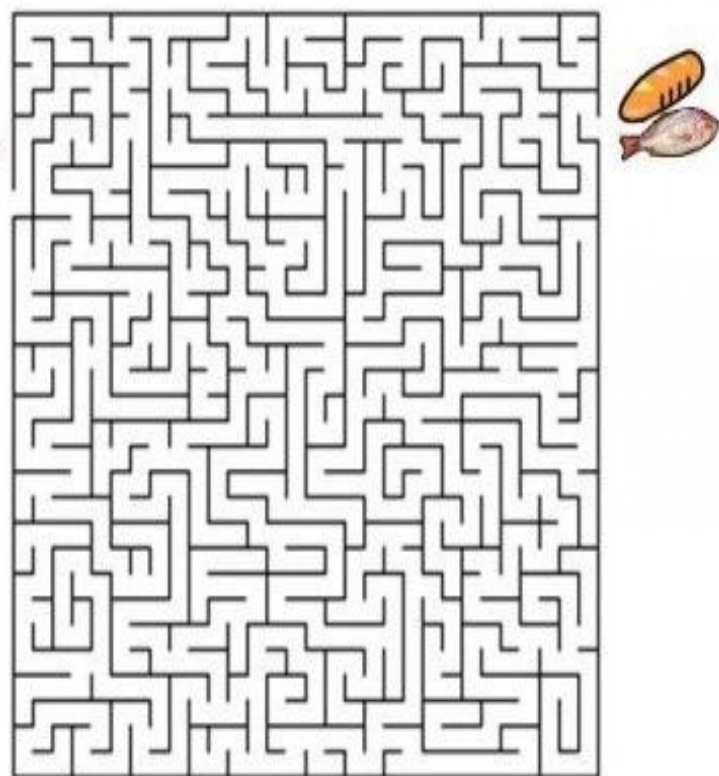

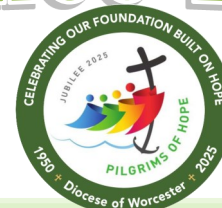

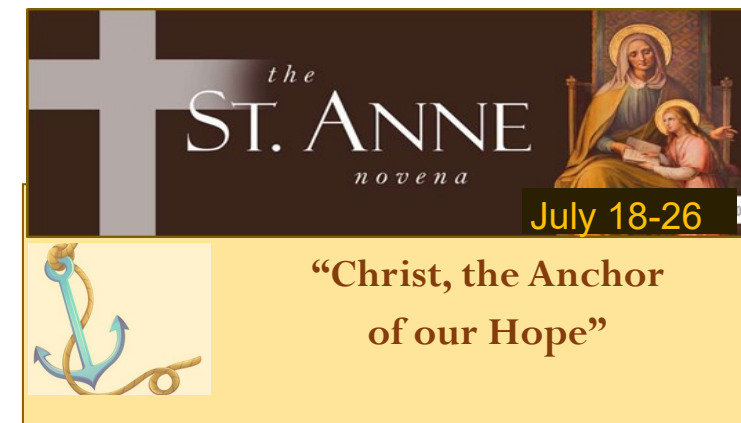

St. Anne St. Patrick Parish is preparing its 138th annual novena to Saint Anne.

This novena of prayer is only offered once a year. It is a way for people to practice devotional praying. To pray to and offer thanksgiving to Saint Anne.

The first day of the novena is Friday, July 18, and it concludes on Saturday, July 26. (Only 4 weeks away)

Since the first healing occurred at St. Anne - St. Patrick, people have come to this holy place seeking solace and peace. There is power in praying together, so please join us for one or more of the nine evenings.

Each evening offers time for confessions, a rosary procession, and a novena Mass. Beginning at 5:30 p.m., confessions will be available for people who want the Sacrament of Penance. At 6:30 p.m., the rosary procession will begin from the Generations Statue in front of the gift shop. Mass will start at 7:00 p.m. in the outdoor pavilion. On the last day, there will be a morning Mass at 11:00 a.m. for the anointing of the sick.
