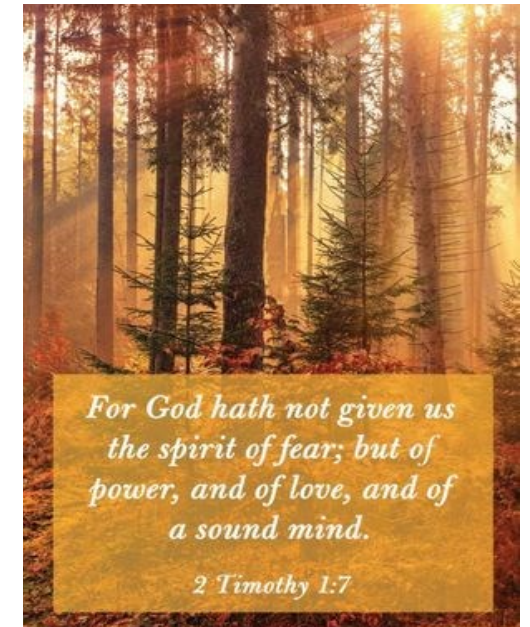

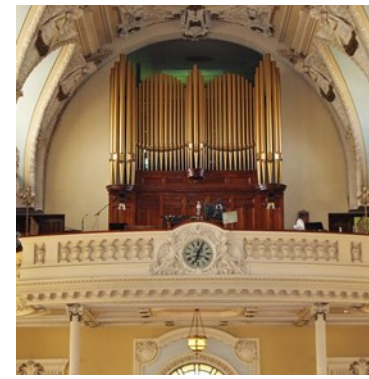
**Notre Dame Church

## Worcester Public Schools Sex Ed

Under the current Worcester Public Schools sex-ed program, *Rights, Respect, Responsibility*, was launched in the Fall of 2021 and continues to be implemented each school year. Kindergarteners will be asked to place "post it" labels on diagrams of male and female genitals. Fifth graders will be asked to color in diagrams of male and female sex organs as the teacher discusses them. Sixth graders will hear about the details of oral and anal sex.
