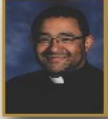
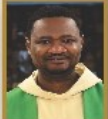
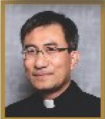

Since 1887, pilgrims and parishioners have gathered at Saint Anne Shrine for the annual Novena, first celebrated with a procession of thanksgiving for miraculous healings.

The Novena is always held **July 18 through July 26**, for the Feast of Saints Anne and Joachim. Each evening begins with a procession and the Rosary, followed by Mass. On the final day, we celebrate a special Mass for Healing and honor grandparents in a particular way.

The theme of this year’s Novena is “One in Christ, United in Mission” and we invite all parishioners, visitors, and pilgrims to join us in deepening our relationship with Christ in the Eucharist. Whether you come for one evening or for all nine days, we look forward to celebrating this beautiful tradition with you.

To help make this sacred event welcoming and safe for all, **the parish needs volunteers** with medical experience, such as nurses, doctors, and paramedics; parking attendants; shuttle drivers; and trained security.

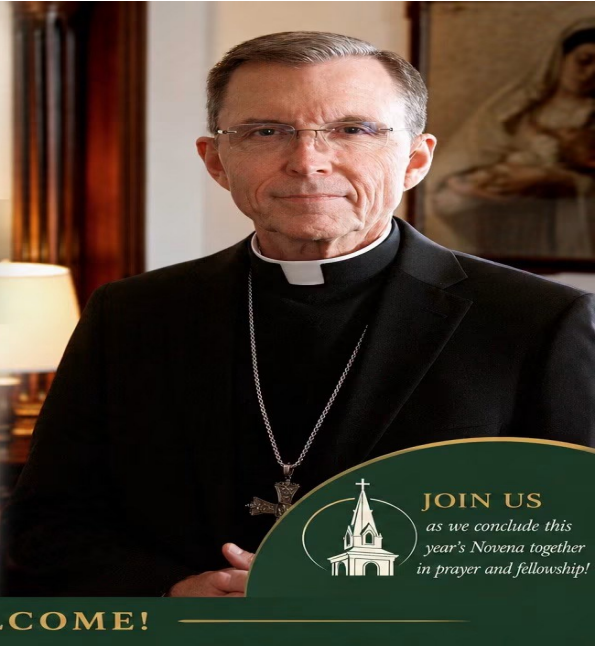
