"The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field...He who sows good seed is the Son of Man, the field is the world, the good seed the children of the kingdom." (Matthew 13:24, 37-38)

As children of God, we are all "good seeds." We are blessed by God with the potential to accomplish much good in the world. We fulfill God's plan when we spend time in prayer every day, use our skills to help others, and share our financial gifts to help build God's kingdom on earth. Through our example of gratitude and generosity, we sow "good seeds" on earth and ultimately help each other get to Heaven!

As a follow-up to Fr. Reidy's homily this past weekend and his encouragement to read the Holy Scriptures daily, here are a few resources that might be helpful:

1. Ignatius Bible and Commentaries

- i. The *Ignatius Bible*, or the Revised Standard Version-Catholic Edition, is one of the most popular translations of the Bible in the Catholic community. It is in contemporary English without unnecessary filters or "dumbed-down" text.
- ii. There are many scriptural commentaries and guides which use the Ignatius Bible including ones written by widely acclaimed Scripture Scholars Scott Hahn, John Bergsma, Brant Pitre, and others.
- iii. You can purchase the Ignatius Bible as a whole or as separate parts.

2. Navarre Bible Commentaries

- i. The *Navarre Bible* is a set of extensive commentary which provides an in-depth "intellectual, historical, and spiritual approach to each book of the Bible which is "scholarly yet readable."
- ii. The *Navarre Bible* is most often sold as small sections or individual books of the Bible.

3. The Didache Bible

- i. The *Didache Bible*, produced by the Midwest Theological Forum, offers a uniquely catechetical approach to the Holy Scriptures.
- ii. *The Didache Bible* is meant to assist the reader in understanding the history and purpose of Catholic Church teaching especially as expressed in the Catechism.

4. The Word on Fire Bible

- i. Based on the New Revised Standard Version, the *Word on Fire Bible* is tailored to people who are reading the Bible seriously for the first time. This beautiful Bible is available in leather, hardcover, and paperback.
- ii. Commentaries from the early Church fathers, recent saints and authors such as St. John Paul II and G.K. Chesterton, and Bishop Robert Barron are included beside relevant Scripture passages.
- iii. Thus far the only part of the *Word on Fire Bible* available is the Gospels. Other sections are yet to be published.
