## THE SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

Today, the Church pauses in profound adoration to contemplate the greatest gift ever given to humanity: the Holy Eucharist. The Solemnity of Corpus Christi is not just a feast of remembrance—it is a living encounter with Christ Himself, truly present in the Sacrament of the Altar.

On this day, we gaze with wonder at the mystery of the Body and Blood of Jesus, hidden under the appearances of bread and wine. What seems ordinary is, in truth, extraordinary. What appears simple is infinitely profound. In the Most Holy Eucharist, Christ fulfills His promise: “I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” (Matthew 28:20) Here, in every tabernacle, on every altar, in every Mass, Jesus remains with His Church—not symbolically, not figuratively, but truly, substantially, completely.

He comes to us in silence, with humility, veiled in sacramental mystery, offering Himself as food for the journey and strength for our weakness. The Eucharist is not a mere ritual. It is not a symbol of something absent. It is Jesus Himself, crucified and risen, offering His very life again and again for the salvation of the world.

At every Mass, Calvary is made present—not repeated, but present. Heaven touches earth. Angels kneel with us. The saints join our song. And the same Christ who once walked the dusty roads of Galilee now comes to walk the roads of our hearts, to dwell within us, to unite us with Himself.

To receive the Eucharist is to be loved beyond measure. Jesus does not give us things—He gives us Himself. In the gift of the Eucharist, He enters our poverty, our sin, our woundedness, and says, “This is my Body, given up for you.” He allows Himself to be consumed, so that we may be consumed by love. As Saint Augustine said, “You will not change Me into yourself, as you do with food, but you will be changed into Me.”

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi is also a call to adoration and mission. Adoration because such love demands our reverence, our silence, our awe. And mission, because having received Christ, we are now sent to become what we receive. We are called to be broken for others, to pour ourselves out in service, to be living tabernacles in the world—carriers of the divine presence into every conversation, every workplace, every home.

Let us renew our love for the Mass, for the tabernacle, for Eucharistic adoration. Let us approach Holy Communion with reverence, with hearts made ready through prayer and repentance. For in this Sacrament, Heaven begins. In this Sacrament, the heart of God beats for us.

O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, All praise and all thanksgiving Be every moment Thine.

**LA SOLEMNIDAD DE CORPUS CHRISTI**

Hoy, la Iglesia se detiene en profunda adoración para contemplar el don más grande jamás dado a la humanidad: la Sagrada Eucaristía. La Solemnidad de Corpus Christi no es solo una fiesta de conmemoración, sino un encuentro vivo con Cristo mismo, verdaderamente presente en el Sacramento del Altar.

En este día, contemplamos con asombro el misterio del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús, oculto bajo las apariencias del pan y el vino. Lo que parece ordinario es, en verdad, extraordinario. Lo que parece sencillo es infinitamente profundo. En la Santísima Eucaristía, Cristo cumple su promesa: «Yo estoy con vosotros todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo» (Mateo 28,20). Aquí, en cada sagrario, en cada altar, en cada misa, Jesús permanece con su Iglesia, no simbólica ni figurativamente, sino verdadera, sustancial y completamente.

Él viene a nosotros en silencio, con humildad, velado por el misterio sacramental, ofreciéndose como alimento para el camino y fortaleza para nuestra debilidad. La Eucaristía no es un mero ritual. No es un símbolo de algo ausente. Es Jesús mismo, crucificado y resucitado, ofreciendo su vida una y otra vez por la salvación del mundo.

En cada Misa, el Calvario se hace presente; no se repite, sino que se representa. El Cielo toca la tierra. Los ángeles se arrodillan con nosotros. Los santos se unen a nuestro canto. Y el mismo Cristo que una vez recorrió los polvorientos caminos de Galilea ahora viene a recorrer los caminos de nuestros corazones, a morar en nosotros, a unirnos a Él.

Recibir la Eucaristía es ser amado sin medida. Jesús no nos da cosas; se da a sí mismo. En el don de la Eucaristía, entra en nuestra pobreza, nuestro pecado, nuestra herida, y dice: «Este es mi Cuerpo, entregado por vosotros». Se deja consumir para que seamos consumidos por el amor. Como dijo San Agustín: «No me transformarás en ti mismo, como haces con la comida, sino que serás transformado en Mí».

La Solemnidad del Corpus Christi es también un llamado a la adoración y a la misión. Adoración porque este amor exige nuestra reverencia, nuestro silencio, nuestro asombro. Y misión, porque habiendo recibido a Cristo, ahora somos enviados a convertirnos en lo que recibimos. Estamos llamados a entregarnos por los demás, a entregarnos al servicio, a ser tabernáculos vivientes en el mundo: portadores de la presencia divina en cada conversación, cada lugar de trabajo, cada hogar.

Renovemos nuestro amor por la Misa, por el sagrario, por la adoración eucarística. Acerquémonos a la Sagrada Comunión con reverencia, con corazones preparados por la oración y el arrepentimiento. Porque en este Sacramento comienza el Cielo. En este Sacramento, el corazón de Dios late por nosotros.

Oh Sacramento Santísimo, Oh Sacramento Divino, toda alabanza y toda acción de gracias sean Tuyas en todo momento.
