

“Called to Serve as Lay Disciples”

In Baptism, every Catholic receives a call—not just to believe, but to serve. This is not a calling reserved for priests or religious. It is a vocation written on the hearts of all the faithful: to be light in the darkness, salt of the earth, and witnesses of God’s love in the world.

As lay people, our mission field is vast. It is the home, the workplace, the school, the community. We are called to carry Christ not only into the church building, but into every corner of society—through our actions, our words, and most powerfully, through our love.

To serve in the Church is not about titles or positions. It is about having a heart like Christ—humble, compassionate, willing to put others first. Whether we serve as catechists, musicians, lectors, Eucharistic ministers, volunteers, or simply as faithful parishioners who pray and support others, every act of service matters deeply in the eyes of God.

The beauty of lay ministry is that it flows from everyday life. Parents serve by raising their children in the faith. Workers serve by living with integrity. Neighbors serve by showing kindness. Our witness is most powerful when we bring our faith into the ordinary and allow God to make it extraordinary.

This is the Church: one Body, many members, each with a role to play. If we wait to be perfect before we serve, we will wait forever. God does not call the qualified; He qualifies the called.

So let us listen. Let us respond. The harvest is great—and we are the laborers He sends. May we rise each day with open hands and open hearts, ready to serve the Lord by serving His people.
