


The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

Solemnity of Christ the King & Thanksgiving**Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,**

As we gather this weekend to celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, our hearts are also preparing for Thanksgiving Day. These two celebrations—one rooted in our faith, the other in our nation—meet beautifully in the heart of a Christian. One proclaims who Christ is: our King, our Savior, our Shepherd. The other invites us to remember who we are: a people blessed beyond measure.

The Gospel this Sunday shows us a King who does not sit on a golden throne, but who reigns from the cross. A King who answers insults with mercy, who responds to a criminal's final cry with a promise of Paradise. A King whose greatest act of power was not domination, but redemption.

On the cross, Jesus shows us that true kingship is not about being served, but about serving. Not about receiving honors, but about giving love.

And so today, we look to Christ our King and we see a heart that never stops loving, never stops forgiving, never stops saving. A heart that welcomes the lost, lifts the burdened, and restores the broken. A heart that says to every soul that turns to Him, "You are Mine. Come home."

This week, as we prepare to celebrate Thanksgiving, we are invited to do something deeply Christian: to see our blessings through the eyes of Christ the King.

To recognize that every good thing in our lives—every breath, every act of love, every moment of hope—is a gift that flows from the heart of our Savior.

Thanksgiving is not just a holiday; it is a spiritual posture. It is the attitude of a heart that knows it has been saved. It is the echo of the repentant thief who, even in pain, found the courage to whisper, "Lord, remember me." And Christ answered him with a promise that changed everything.

So what do we give thanks for this year?

For a King who rules by mercy. For a Lord who walks with us in every season. For a Savior who sees beauty in our brokenness. For a God who transforms crosses into resurrections. For faith, for family, for community, for the grace to begin again.

My dear Saint Louis family, as your pastor I give thanks for each one of you. Your faith, your kindness, your sacrifices, your quiet prayers, your presence in this parish—they are gifts to God and to this community. You help build the Kingdom not with crowns and scepters, but with generosity, service, and love.

May this week be a time of gratitude, healing, and closeness to God. And may Christ our King, who reigns with wounded hands and a merciful heart, bless your homes, your families, and your Thanksgiving tables with His peace.

Christ is our King. Thanksgiving is our response. And together, we walk toward His Kingdom of love.

Solemnidad de Cristo Rey & Día de Acción de Gracias

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Al reunirnos este fin de semana para celebrar la Solemnidad de Jesucristo, Rey del Universo, nuestros corazones también se preparan para el Día de Acción de Gracias. Estas dos celebraciones—una centrada en nuestra fe, la otra en nuestra nación—se encuentran de manera hermosa en el corazón del cristiano. Una proclama quién es Cristo: nuestro Rey, nuestro Salvador, nuestro Pastor. La otra nos invita a recordar quiénes somos: un pueblo bendecido más allá de toda medida.

El Evangelio de este domingo nos muestra a un Rey que no se sienta en un trono de oro, sino que reina desde la cruz. Un Rey que responde a los insultos con misericordia, que escucha el clamor final de un criminal y lo recibe con la promesa del Paraíso. Un Rey cuyo acto más grande de poder no fue dominar, sino redimir. En la cruz, Jesús nos muestra que la verdadera realeza no consiste en ser servido, sino en servir. No en recibir honores, sino en dar amor.

Hoy miramos a Cristo nuestro Rey y vemos un corazón que nunca deja de amar, nunca deja de perdonar, nunca deja de salvar. Un corazón que acoge al perdido, levanta al caído y restaura al quebrantado. Un corazón que le dice a cada alma que se vuelve a Él: “Eres mío. Ven a casa.”
