


# ***Second Sunday of Advent II Domingo de Adviento***

### Second Sunday of Advent – Reflection

**My dear brothers and sisters,**

Advent is a season of hope, peace, joy and love, a time when the Church invites us to pause, reflect, and prepare our hearts for the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Today, the Gospel reminds us of John the Baptist, the voice crying out in the wilderness: “Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths.”

John’s message is both urgent and simple: we are called to prepare. But what does this preparation mean for us today? It is not about frantic activity or checking off tasks; it is about opening our hearts to God’s presence, clearing away anything that blocks our love for Him and for others. Advent is a time to reflect on our lives, to seek forgiveness, to let go of pride, anger, or fear, and to make room for Jesus to dwell within us.

John the Baptist points to a powerful truth: it is not enough to wait passively for Jesus. We are invited to act, to change, to convert. Our faith calls us to align our words, thoughts, and actions with God’s will. Even small steps—prayer, kindness, forgiveness—can make a straight path for the Lord in our hearts.

As we light the second candle on the Advent wreath, let it remind us of preparation, peace and hope. Hope is not passive wishful thinking; it is trusting that God is faithful, even when life feels uncertain. Hope compels us to live with peace and joy, to reach out to others, and to keep our eyes fixed on Christ, who is coming into our lives in ways big and small.

Let us ask ourselves:

- What is cluttering my heart that keeps me from truly welcoming Jesus?
- How can I make straight a path for Him in my daily life?
- Where is God inviting me to bring peace and hope to someone else this week?

Advent is God’s invitation to transformation. Let us walk boldly into this season, allowing John’s voice to echo within us: Prepare the way of the Lord. Make your heart a home for Christ. And may the hope, peace, and love of this season fill every corner of your life. *Fr. Javier.*

## Segundo Domingo de Adviento – Reflexión

Hermanos y hermanas,

El Adviento es un tiempo de esperanza, paz, alegría y amor un momento en que la Iglesia nos invita a detenernos, reflexionar y preparar nuestro corazón para la venida de nuestro Salvador, Jesucristo. Hoy, el Evangelio nos presenta a Juan Bautista, la voz que clama en el desierto: “Preparad el camino del Señor, enderezad sus senderos.”

El mensaje de Juan es claro y urgente: estamos llamados a prepararnos. Pero, ¿qué significa esta preparación hoy para nosotros? No se trata de actividades frenéticas ni de cumplir tareas; se trata de abrir nuestro corazón a la presencia de Dios, limpiar todo aquello que impide nuestro amor a Él y a los demás. El Adviento nos invita a reflexionar sobre nuestra vida, a buscar perdón, a dejar atrás el orgullo, la ira o el miedo, y a hacer espacio para que Jesús habite en nosotros.

Juan Bautista nos recuerda algo profundo: no basta esperar pasivamente a Jesús. Estamos invitados a actuar, cambiar y convertirnos. Nuestra fe nos llama a alinear nuestras palabras, pensamientos y acciones con la voluntad de Dios. Incluso los gestos pequeños —una oración, un acto de bondad, un perdón— pueden allanar el camino del Señor en nuestro corazón.

Al encender la segunda vela de la corona de Adviento, recordemos que representa la preparación, la paz y la esperanza. La esperanza no es un deseo pasivo; es confiar en que Dios es fiel, incluso cuando la vida parece incierta. La esperanza nos impulsa a vivir con alegría, a acercarnos a los demás y a mantener nuestra mirada fija en Cristo, quien viene a nuestra vida de muchas maneras.

Preguntémonos:

- ¿Qué está ocupando mi corazón que me impide acoger verdaderamente a Jesús?
- ¿Cómo puedo allanar el camino del Señor en mi vida diaria?
- ¿Dónde me invita Dios a llevar paz y esperanza a alguien esta semana?

El Adviento es una invitación a la transformación. Caminemos con valentía en esta temporada, dejando que la voz de Juan resuene en nosotros: Preparad el camino del Señor. Hagamos de nuestro corazón un hogar para Cristo, y que la esperanza, la paz y el amor de esta temporada llenen cada rincón de nuestra vida. *P. Javier*
