Do not stay away. Do not carry your burdens alone. Come. Let Christ heal your heart this Lent.

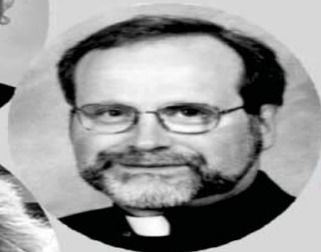

Transfiguration Sunday

On the mountain, Jesus reveals His glory — but only for a moment. The light of the Transfiguration is not meant to help the disciples escape the Cross; it is meant to strengthen them to face it.

During Lent, the Lord also takes us up the mountain. In prayer, in silence, in the Eucharist, He allows us to glimpse His light. We want to stay there, like Peter: “Lord, it is good that we are here.” But Lent reminds us that we cannot build tents in moments of consolation. We must walk back down the mountain.

The Father’s voice still speaks: “This is my beloved Son... listen to Him.”

Listen to Him when He calls you to conversion.

Listen to Him when He asks you to forgive.

Listen to Him when He invites you to carry your cross.

And when fear overwhelms us, Jesus does what He did for the disciples — He comes close, touches us, and says: “Rise, and do not be afraid.”

At the end, they saw “no one else but Jesus alone.”

That is Lent.

To lose everything that distracts us... until only Jesus remains.

Escúchenlo cuando los invita a cargar su cruz.

Y cuando el miedo nos paraliza, Jesús se acerca, nos toca y nos dice: «Levántense, no tengan miedo.»

Al final, los discípulos no vieron a nadie más que a Jesús solo.

Eso es la Cuaresma:

que desaparezca todo lo que nos distrae... hasta que solo quede Jesús.

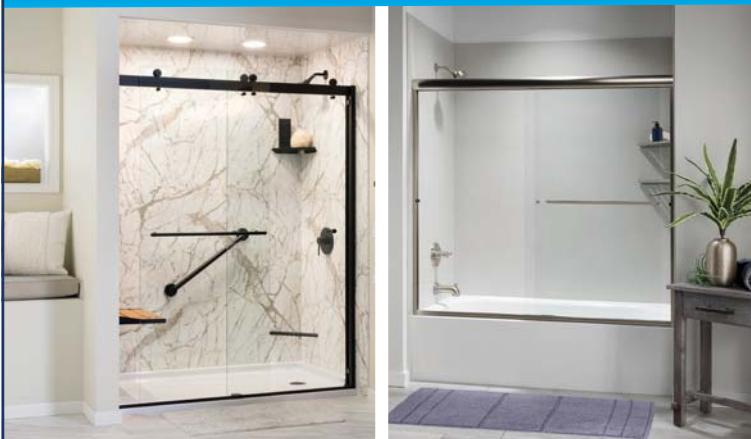
