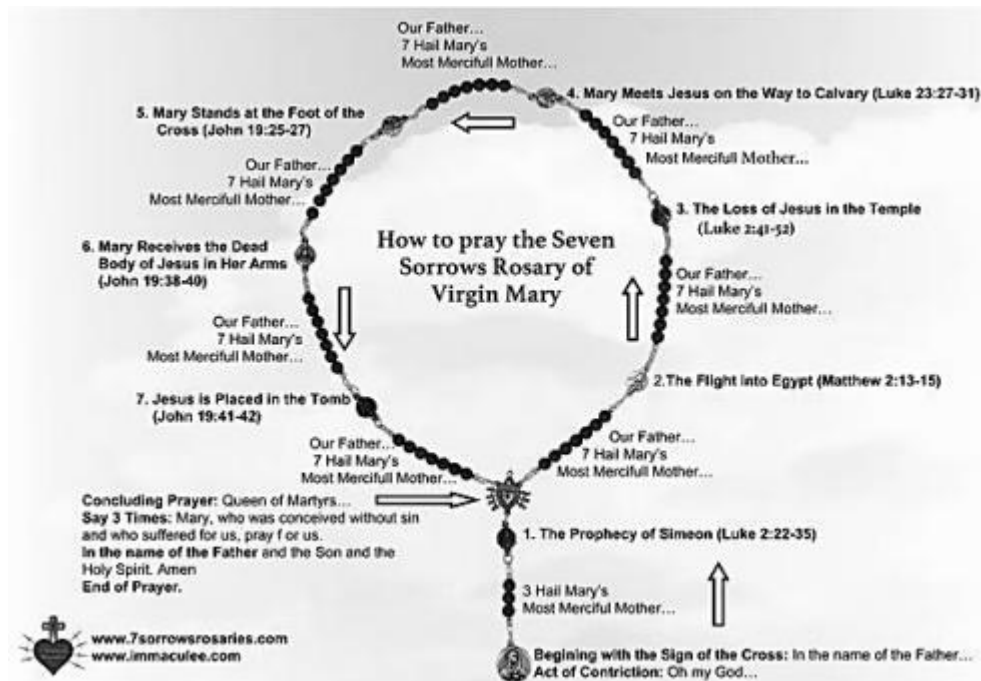

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends,

During our class on Divine Mercy, we spoke together of our Blessed Mother and her role in Divine Mercy. We ended up speaking of a devotion known as the Seven Sorrows Rosary. This Rosary is a bit different because unlike the normal rosary which has 5 sets of 10 Hail Mary beads each (5 Decades) and 4 sets of Mysteries (Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful, and Glorious), this has 7 sets of 7. See this chart below:



There are promises associated with this rosary. First St. Bridget of Sweden had the following revealed to her about meditating on Mary's sorrows:

I will grant peace to their families.

They will be enlightened about the Divine Mysteries.

I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work.

I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my Divine Son or the sanctification of their souls.

I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives.

I will visibly help them at the moment of their death - they will see the face of their mother.

I have obtained this grace from my Divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and Sorrows will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness, since all their sins will be forgiven and my Son will be their eternal consolation and joy.

Finally, in Kibeho Rwanda, Our Lady appeared to three visionaries in 1980's – Only a few years before the Rwandan Genocide. To her regarding this devotion, Our Lady revealed the following:

With the recitation of Seven Sorrows Rosary, the hardest hearts shall change, if you pray it for yourself or for others.

By the recitation of the Seven Sorrows Rosary, you shall be freed from obsessions and addictions.

This rosary when said from the heart, it will win us true repentance of our sins and free our souls from guilt and remorse.

Those who say it often, especially as recommended by Our Lady to Marie Claire, on Tuesdays & Fridays, shall obtain clear understanding of their weaknesses and flaws causing them to sin and those things we don't like about ourselves and thought were a part of our character, shall change.

You shall obtain whatever you ask for through this rosary, praying this rosary from the heart.

More than ever, the world needs the Seven Sorrows Rosary.

With this in mind, let us pray together: Our Lady of Sorrows, pray for us.

The Indian Missionary Society was founded in 1941 in the City of Varanasi also known as the Vatican of Hinduism with the view of preaching the Good News among the people of other faiths. After 75 years IMS has grown into a matured religious order of Pontifical Rite with over 300 priests and some 450 seminarians at various stages of formation. The priests of the Delhi province work mostly in the villages. They run schools in these villages. They also have hostels for poor boys and girls. They work in the promotion of village health, adult education, education of children. They are heavily involved in the Social Justice issues as well. The money that you give this year will be used to support two hostels in the Northern Part of India. They take care of close around 160 children in these hostels. These are poor boys and girls who cannot be at home due to poverty. In the hostels they are given education, food, clothing and accommodation. Thank you for your generosity.
