



## A Message from the Pastor...

As we've continued through these uncharted waters of our current world, I can't help but see the many crosses we are carrying. In reflecting on the Saints' lives, one sees that they were sometimes in the most challenging scenarios imaginable. How did they "stay the course"? How do any of us find unity amid the disunity we are seeing?

First and foremost, we must discover or rediscover the heart of Christianity – Prayer. I can see no other way that the Saints could sustain in such difficult circumstances. How else could they testify to the peace they experienced, even in the face of the end of their earthly lives? This is a peace that only comes from God and only comes from discovering His love in a truly personal way.

## Gospel: MT 20:1-16A

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard.' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' When those who had started about five o'clock came, each received the usual daily wage. So when the first came, they thought that they would receive more, but each of them also got the usual wage. And on receiving it they grumbled against the landowner, saying, 'These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat.' He said to one of them in reply, 'My friend, I am not cheating you. Did you not agree with me for the usual daily wage? Take what is yours and go. What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last."



September 26th & 27th.


