





## COMMUNAL ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Saturday, October 20 during the 4:30 pm Mass

In the renewal of the celebration of the sacraments following the Second Vatican Council, many new opportunities have been made available for our spiritual strength and growth. In the Anointing of the Sick, once called the "Last Rites" or "Extreme Unction", the emphasis has changed from a preparation for death to a prayer for life and health. It is no longer a sacrament reserved only for those who are at the point of death, but is also intended for those persons who are aged, undergoing surgery or experiencing a serious or chronic illness. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present.

The celebration of the sacrament will take place after the Liturgy of the Word at Mass and includes the "laying on of hands" which is a calling on the Holy Spirit to rest upon each person, followed by the anointing of the forehead and palm of the hands.
