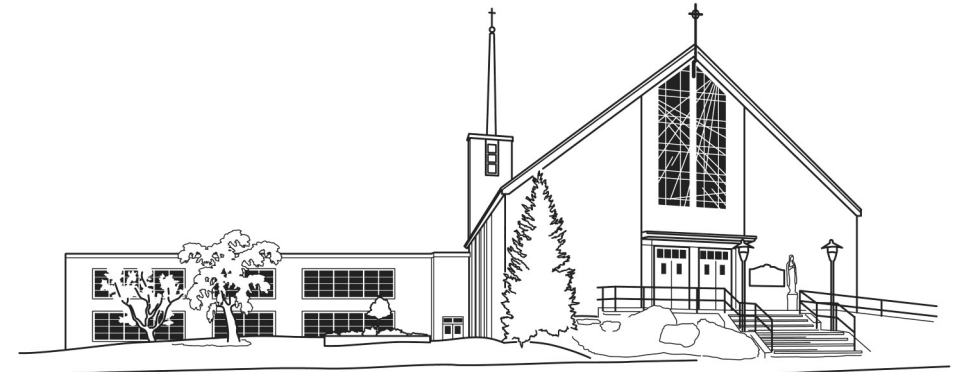

Thank-you for the warm welcome you extended last weekend to Fr. Bernard Dervil, OMI, the new pastor of St. Michel’s in Roche-a-Bateau, Haiti. He was very impressed with vibrant parish community of St. Mary’s and the opportunity to share some time with our Haiti Committee after the Sunday Masses. At a Mass last Saturday with Bishop McManus at St. Paul’s Cathedral, we renewed our covenant with St. Michel’s and look forward to working with Fr. Bernard in the coming years.

Each year at the beginning of November we take up a second collection so that we can continue to make our monthly donation of \$1400 to St. Michel’s. Next weekend special Haiti envelopes will be in the pews for this collection. Our monthly gift pays the salary of nine teachers, helps support the sisters’ health clinic and the operation of the parish and its seven missions. Fr. Bernard and the people of St. Michel’s continue to depend on our monthly gift, and we are grateful that we have been able to sustain this relationship for 22 years. Members of the Haiti Committee will speak at all the Masses next weekend to provide an update on the projects St. Mary’s sponsored last year and how your generous contributions have helped the people of St. Michel’s rebuild after Hurricane Matthew in 2016.

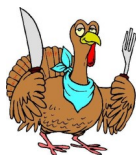
