Fourth Sunday of Easter**May 12th, 2019***"The disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit." Acts 13:52*

In an interview, Art Linkletter recalled some of the more memorable things children said on his television program. In response to the question, "What is love?" one little boy said, "Love is when your name is safe in someone else's mouth." That is a pearl of wisdom from the mouth of a very young observer!

When Jesus is challenged by the crowd to tell them if He is indeed the Messiah, He answers them by saying that He and the Father are one—one in power, one in shepherding His people, one in giving life. Those who believe in the Lord can recognize His voice because He is the Good Shepherd, the One who gives them safety and life. He calls them by name and they are safe in His hands.

Jesus calls us by name in Baptism and in all the sacraments. He calls us to be His followers, to live a life in union with Him and the Father. Through faith, we hear Him and we must answer. We hear His voice in those who cry for justice, those who weep with sorrow, those who suffer from violence and war, and those who do not experience life as God created it and are left in hunger and poverty. Hear the voice of the Lord and help to carry the cross of others. Your name will be safe in the mouth of the Lord!

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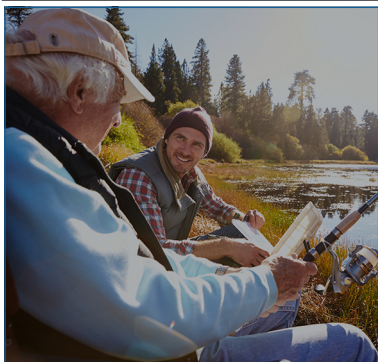
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
