PENTECOST

For us as Catholics, Easter is the greatest feast in the Church; it is followed by Christmas.

However, today, Pentecost Sunday is not far behind in terms of its importance. Today marks the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and other followers of the Lord, and thus it is often called the birthday of the Church. It was on this day, Pentecost, that Jesus fully united with His followers through the Holy Spirit. This is a great day of joy for us as it was on this day that Christ fulfilled His promise to us. *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* (#732) points out, *On that day (Pentecost), the Holy Trinity is fully revealed. Since that day, the Kingdom announced by Christ has been open to those who believe in him: in the humility of the flesh and in faith, they already share in the communion of the Holy Trinity.*

As the Father has sent me, so I send you, says the Lord on that occasion. He gives us a mission; He commissions for us to do what He did. Now, just as then, the Lord sends us out in the world, our world, where we live, where we work, wherever we go, to represent Him and to model Him as best we can. St. Teresa of Calcutta, Mother Teresa, had a real awareness of what it meant to be sent by God. She said, *I am a little pencil in the hand of a writing God, Who is sending a love letter to the world.*

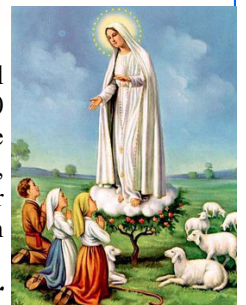
PARTNERS IN CHARITY

UROCZYSTOŚĆ ZESŁANIA DUCHA ŚWIĘTEGO

9 czerwca 2019

*„A Poczyszcieł, Duch Święty, którego Ojciec pośle w moim imieniu,
On was wszystkiego nauczy i przypomni wam wszystko, co Ja wam powiedziałem.” (J 14, 26)*



Wszyscy zrozumieli przesłanie Apostołów, obcy i przybysze, ponieważ przemówili oni ludzkim językiem, budząc tęsknotę ukrytą w sercu człowieka. Nie potrzeba więcej, jak tylko odkryć, że Bóg kocha, i odpowiedzieć na tę miłość. Cud, który się dokonał w dniu zesłania Ducha Świętego, polegał na tym, że każdy usłyszał w swoim sercu głos samego Boga. W tym Głosie ma źródło tajemnica jedności. Upragniony przez wszystkich pokój będzie możliwy, gdy odwołamy się do naszego serca i przemówimy do siebie ludzkim językiem.

Duch Święty jest Boskim darem dla Kościoła i świata, który wprowadza pierwotny porządek Boży: pozwala zachowywać Boże przykazania w Duchu miłości Boga i bliźniego. Jest to porządek przywrócony przez Chrystusa na krzyżu i wdrażany po Jego śmierci i zmartwychwstaniu w Duchu wzajemnej miłości Ojca i Syna zlanego na Kościół w dniu Pięćdziesiątnicy. To właśnie ten Duch Święty sprawia, że od dnia Jego zesłania aż po dziś dzień aktualizuje się na wszystkich pokoleniach ludzkich dzieło zbawcze Jezusa Chrystusa realizowane w Kościele, w sposób sakramentalny. To właśnie w Nim są skuteczne nasze modlitwy, dociera do nas żywe słowo Pisma świętego, a wszelkie wydarzenia naszego życia w wierze są odbierane jako przejaw działania Bożego. Jest On obecny we wszystkich sakramentach Kościoła, szczególnie Eucharystii, sprawiając i aktualizując dzieło zbawcze Jezusa Chrystusa.



Dzisiejsza druga kolekta jest przeznaczona na pokrycie wyższych kosztów utrzymania i energii.

Druga kolekta w przyszłym tygodniu będzie przeznaczona na Zobowiązania Diecezjalne.

PODZIĘKOWANIE DLA KS. PRAŁATA

W związku z planowanym w lipcu przejściem księdza Prałata na emeryturę, w sobotę, 22 czerwca, w centrum parafialnym odbędzie się pożegnalna kolacja, na której będziemy mieli możliwość osobistego podziękowania księdzu Prałatowi za Jego posługę w naszej wspólnocie przez ponad 25 lat. Wstęp na spotkanie, jednak **osoby, które chciwą wziąć w nim udział muszą odebrać bilety**, które dostępne na plebanii, w zakrystii i w szkole.

CATHOLIC COMMUNICATION CAMPAIGN

W następny weekend druga kolekta przeznaczona będzie na **Catholic Communication Campaign**. Ta ogólnonarodowa zbiórka pomaga zanosić przesłanie Ewangelii w sferę publiczną we wszystkich formach mediów, aby wszyscy mogli poznać miłość Boga i móc uczynić ten świat lepszym. Jak napisał Papież Franciszek w tegorocznym Orędziu Komunikacyjnym, że Bóg nie jest Samotnością, ale Komunią; jest Miłością, a więc komunikacją, ponieważ miłość zawsze się komunikuje; rzeczywiście, komunikuje się, aby spotkać się z drugim. Wierna i uczciwa komunikacja w życiu naszej wspólnoty katolickiej służy naszej misji ewangelizacyjnej, dzięki której spotykamy innych, abyśmy mogli dawać świadectwo o Bożej miłości jako prawdziwej drodze do wiecznego szczęścia.

Około połowa zebranych funduszy pozostanie tutaj w diecezji, aby pomóc nam wspierać komunikację skoncentrowaną na parafiach we współpracy z programami diecezjalnymi. Pozostała część wesprze finansowo relacje i działni medialne na na poziomie krajowym, jak również międzynarodowe projekty w krajach rozwijających się. 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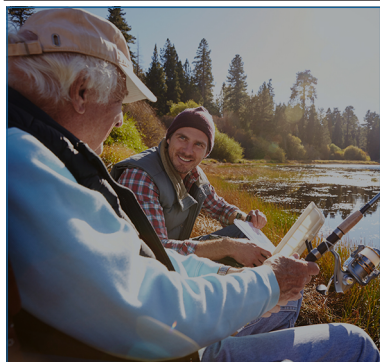
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
