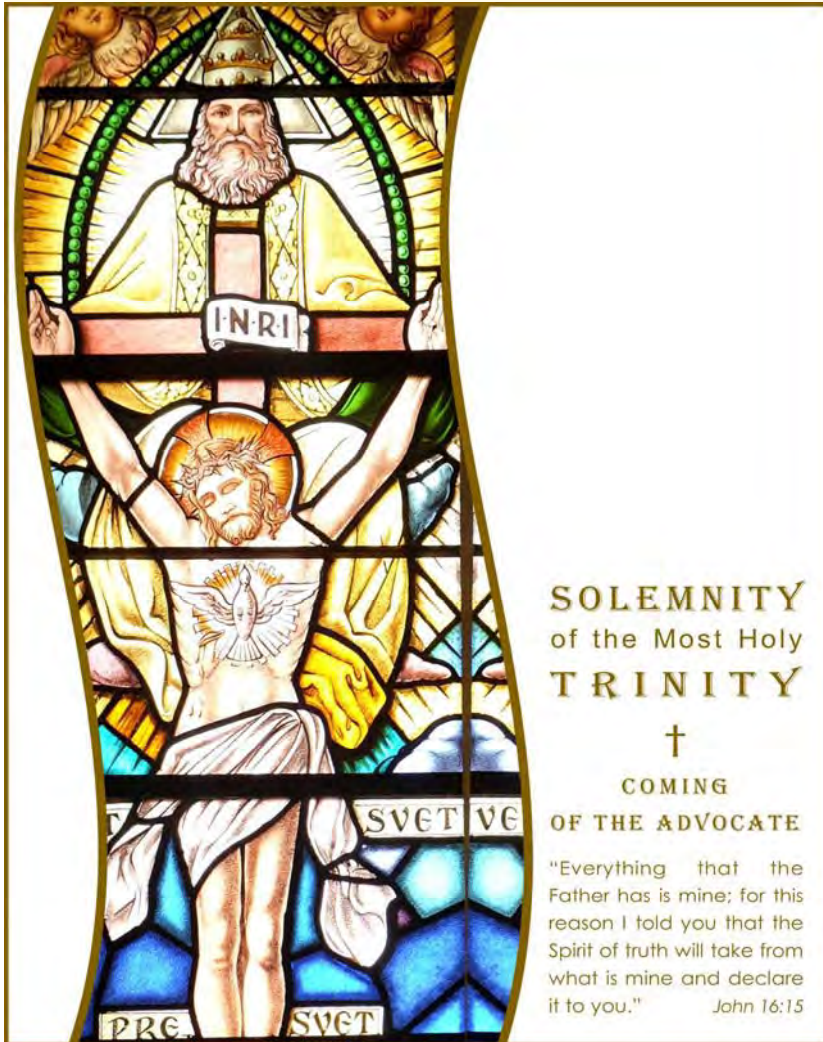

"But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth..." (John 16:13)

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

On the first Sunday after Pentecost, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Below are some teachings from the Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church:

45. Can the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity be known by the light of human reason alone?

God has left some traces of his trinitarian being in creation and in the Old Testament but his inmost being as the Holy Trinity is a mystery which is inaccessible to reason alone or even to Israel's faith before the Incarnation of the Son of God and the sending of the Holy Spirit. This mystery was revealed by Jesus Christ and it is the source of all the other mysteries.

48. How does the Church express her trinitarian faith?

The Church expresses her trinitarian faith by professing a belief in the oneness of God in whom there are three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The three divine Persons are only one God because each of them equally possesses the fullness of the one and indivisible divine nature. They are really distinct from each other by reason of the relations which place them in correspondence to each other. The Father generates the Son; the Son is generated by the Father; the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son.

49. How do the three divine Persons work?

Inseparable in their one substance, the three divine Persons are also inseparable in their activity. The Trinity has one operation, sole and the same. In this one divine action, however, each Person is present according to the mode which is proper to him in the Trinity.

**NIEDZIELA NAJŚWIĘTSZEJ TRÓJCY**

16 czerwca 2019

„Gdy zaś przyjdzie On, Duch Prawdy, doprowadzi was do całej prawdy. „(J 16, 13)



Tak bardzo w dzisiejszym świecie brakuje jedności w życiu rodzinnym, społecznym i politycznym. Wiele byśmy pewnie zyskali i zrobili, gdybyśmy usunęli z naszego życia podziały, które są spowodowane brakiem miłości, bo liczą się tylko nasze pragnienia i wygórowane często ambicje. Zamiast budować – rujnujemy; zamiast dawać pokój – wprowadzamy rozłam. To wszystko jest wynikiem braku miłości.

Prawdziwa miłość swoje źródło ma w Trójcy Świętej. Bóg Ojciec zesłał na świat „Syna, Słowo Prawdy i Ducha Uświęciela”, jak słyszymy w dzisiejszej kolekcie, tylko dlatego abyśmy zrozumieli ekonomię Bożej miłości, która inna jest od ludzkiej. Jedność Bożych Osób wzywa nas dzisiaj do jedności z całym Kościołem Powszechnym, ale również i z Kościołem domowym, który jest pierwszą świątynią w życiu chrześcijanina – co często podkreślał św. Jan Paweł II.

Niech dzisiejsze słuchanie słowa Bożego i uczestnictwo w Świętej Liturgii wzbudzi w naszych sercach pragnienie jedności z Bogiem w Jego zbawczym słowie. Bo słowa, które On do nas kieruje nie są o kimś kiedyś, ale o nas, żyjących teraz, w XXI wieku.

Dzisiejsza druga kolekta jest przeznaczona na Catholic Communication Campaign.

W bieżący weekend druga kolekta przeznaczona będzie na **Catholic Communication Campaign**.

Ta ogólnonarodowa zbiórka pomaga zanosić przesłanie Ewangelii w sferę publiczną we wszystkich formach mediów, aby wszyscy mogli poznać miłość Boga i móc uczynić ten świat lepszym. Jak napisał Papież Franciszek w tegorocznym Orędziu Komunikacyjnym, że Bóg nie jest Samotnością, ale Komunią; jest Miłością, a więc komunikacją, ponieważ miłość zawsze się komunikuje; rzeczywiście, komunikuje się, aby spotkać się z drugim. Wierna i uczciwa komunikacja w życiu naszej wspólnoty katolickiej służy naszej misji ewangelizacyjnej, dzięki której spotykamy innych, abyśmy mogli dawać świadectwo o Bożej miłości jako prawdziwej drodze do wiecznego szczęścia.

Około połowa zebranych funduszy pozostanie w diecezji, aby pomóc nam wspierać komunikację skoncentrowaną na parafiach we współpracy z programami diecezjalnymi. Pozostała część wesprze finansowo relacje i działania medialne na poziomie krajowym, jak również międzynarodowe projekty w krajach rozwijających się. 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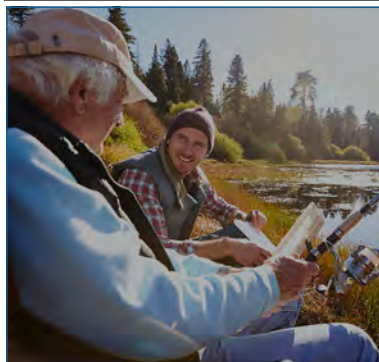
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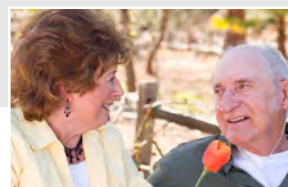
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
