ASH WEDNESDAY

The Season of Lent is a time of preparation for Easter and recalls the forty days Jesus spent in the desert preparing for His public ministry. During this time, a spirit of penance, conversion and prayer prepares the Church to celebrate the Easter mysteries. Lent begins on Ash

Wednesday with the imposition of ashes from burnt palm on the heads or foreheads of the faithful as a sign of repentance.

Lent is a time of somber reflection, sacrifice, fasting, prayer and works of charity. It is the time of retreat for the Church. Many people undertake special practices during Lent, especially attending daily Mass. Personal sacrifices and penance should help a person address his or her personal spiritual needs, or help overcome a failing or strengthen one's resistance to temptation. The backbone of all penitential practice consists of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

LENTEN DEVOTIONAL SCHEDULE

Gorzkie Zale (singing of Lenten lamentations) are scheduled each Saturday at 5pm (English) and Sunday at 11:30am (Polish).

Stations of the Cross will be every Friday at 1:00 pm (School), 6:00pm (English) and 7:00 pm (Polish).

Confessions daily after the 6:30 am Mass and on Saturdays after the 7am Mass and at 3:15 pm.

Children's Mass will be every Sunday at 9:00 am.

LENTEN FASTING REGULATIONS

Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. **Abstinence from meat** is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent. **Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.**

There is no second collection this week.

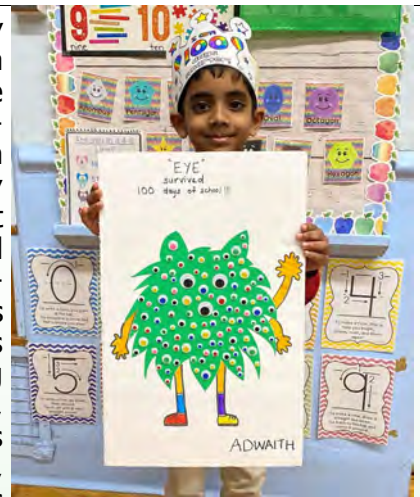

- post jakościowy, czyli powstrzymanie się od pokarmów mięsnych w Środę Popielcową, Wielki Piątek oraz wszystkie piątki Wielkiego Postu przez wszystkich od 14 roku życia,

- post ilościowy, czyli ograniczenie ilości spożywanych posiłków do jednego pełnego posiłku i dwóch dla ewentualnego zaspokożenia głodu i utrzymania sił do pracy. Ten rodzaj postu obowiązuje w Środę Popielcową i Wielki Piątek wszystkich, którzy ukończyli 18 rok życia i nie i nie zakończyli jeszcze 59 roku życia.

Zachęcamy do podejmowania nie tylko wyznaczonych postów, które są obowiązkowe, ale również osobistego podejścia do duchowej odnowy poprzez uczynki miłosierdzia, udział w nabożeństwach wielkopostnych i podejmowane wyrzeczenia i postanowienia.
