RE- OPENING OF THE BASILICA

Weekend masses will be celebrated at the regular times and accessible for parishioners to attend.

However, we need to follow certain rules and restrictions:

- Everyone has to wear a mask.
- All members of the congregation are required to observe a minimum of a 6-foot social distance. (Members living in the same home can sit closer in the pew.) Also a 6-foot distance has to be kept entering and exiting the church.
- Communion will be distributed only in the hand.
- There will be no collection during the Mass. Baskets will be available at the entrances.
- No hymnals will be available in the pews.
- No congregational singing is allowed.
- There will be no offertory procession as well as the entrance and recessional processions.
- No sign of peace.

Continuing Suspension of the Sunday Obligation

Because older adults and those with underlying health conditions continue to be advised to avoid public assemblies, the suspension of the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays will remain in force until December 31, 2020.

Masses will continue to be streamed live for those who are not comfortable to attend in person.

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Since you are not able to attend Mass physically, you may watch it on TV and receive spiritual communion. Begin by examining your conscience and making a good Act of Contrition. Then pray one of the prayers recommended by the Saints for inviting Christ into your heart. Here is one by Saint Alphonsus Liguori:

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love you above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already there, and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.

ST. BENEDICT, ABBOT

Benedict was born into a distinguished family in central Italy, studied at Rome, and early in life was drawn to monasticism. At first he became a hermit, leaving a depressing world—pagan armies on the march, the Church torn by schism, people suffering from war, morality at a low ebb.

He soon realized that he could not live a hidden life in a small town any better than in a large city, so he withdrew to a cave high in the mountains for three years. Some monks chose Benedict as their leader for a while, but found his strictness not to their taste. Still the shift from hermit to community life had begun for him. He had an idea of gathering various families of monks into one "Grand Monastery" to give them the benefit of unity, fraternity, and permanent worship in one house. Finally he began to build what was to become one of the most famous monasteries in the world—Monte Cassino, commanding three narrow valleys running toward the mountains north of Naples.

The Rule that gradually developed prescribed a life of liturgical prayer, study, manual labor, and living together in community under a common abbot. Benedictine asceticism is known for its moderation, and Benedictine charity has always shown concern for the people in the surrounding countryside. In the course of the Middle Ages, all monasticism in the West was gradually brought under the *Rule of St. Benedict*.

In 1964, in view of the work of monks following the Benedictine Rule in the evangelization and civilization of so many European countries in the Middle Ages, Pope Paul VI proclaimed him the patron saint of all Europe.

Today the Benedictine family is represented by two branches: the Benedictine Federation encompassing the men and women of the Order of St. Benedict, and the Cistercians, men and women of the Order of Cistercians of the Strict Observance.

CZTERNASTA NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

5 lipca, 2020

"Albowiem jarzmo moje jest słodkie, a moje brzemię lekkie." (Mt 11, 30)



Jezus pragnie mnie wzmocnić. Staram się dobrze zrozumieć, co chce mi przez to objawić. Warunki Jego pocieszenia są jasne. On nie żąda ode mnie przestrzegania w życiu skomplikowanych reguł i praktyk. Nie chce nakładać na mnie więcej ponad to, co sam niósł. Chce, żebym wziął na siebie ten sam ciężar, który On dźwigał. Potrzebne mi są siły do niesienia duchowego ciężaru mojego życia. Wsparcie Jezusa nie jest pokrzepieniem fizycznym ani pocieszeniem psychicznym. Jezus chce, żebym w swoich dramatach i radościach nie zapominał, że On zawsze na mnie czeka, żebym przychodził do Niego również ze swoimi grzechami, żebym przychodził do Niego ze wszystkim. Kiedy to robię, uczę się od Niego, czym jest moje życie. I doświadczam, że On jest przy mnie. On dzieli ze mną wszystko. Wtedy odkrywam, że choćby w niewielkim stopniu, ale mogę Go naśladować. Że naśladowanie Go jest dla mnie możliwe. Wtedy moja dusza uzyskuje spokój. Doświadczylem tego już niejedną raz i chcę o tym pamiętać. Nasze przyjście do Chrystusa oznacza poddanie się Jego prowadzeniu. Jego władzę nad nami przyjmujemy na zasadzie wyboru serca bez jakiegokolwiek przymusu.



**KORONKA DO
MIŁOSIERDZIA
BOŻEGO**

Dziś pierwsza niedziela lipca. Jak co miesiąc zgromadzimy się o godz. 15:00 na Koronce do Miłosierdzia Bożego. W godzinie śmierci naszego Pana, kiedy pokonane zostały grzech i śmierć, możemy uwielbić Boga za jego wielką i nieskończoną miłość, oraz za nadzieję w trudach i przeciwnościach życia, szczególnie zaś za łaskawą pomoc w zmaganiach ze słabościami, pokusami i grzechem.
Nabożeństwo będzie transmitowane.

**W środę, 8 lipca nie będzie Mszy św. o godz. 6:30.
Zapraszamy na Mszę wotywną i Nowennę do św. Józefa godz. 19:00.**

Dzisiejsza druga kolekta jest przeznaczona na pokrycie kosztów utrzymania i energii.

Druga kolekta w przyszłym tygodniu będzie przeznaczona na Zobowiązania Diecezjalne.



Święty Benedykt urodził się ok. 480 roku w rodzinie szlacheckiej w Nursji. Nie zachowało się zbyt wiele świadectw pisanych dotyczących jego osoby. Podstawowym źródłem pozwalającym odczytać jego duchową sylwetkę jest napisana przez niego Reguła oraz pochodzący z końca VI w. Żywot autorstwa papieża św. Grzegorza i Wielkiego, zawartym w drugiej księdze Dialogów.

Według świadectwa św. Grzegorza, młody Benedykt został wysłany na studia do Rzymu. Widząc jednak zepsucie moralne i upadek intelektualny, zdecydował się przerwać studia i poświęcić się modlitwie oraz życiu ascetycznemu. Przebywał najpierw w pustelni w okolicach Subiaco w środkowej Italii, gdzie pod opieką starszego mnicha prowadził życie pustelnicze. Po kilku latach został poproszony przez mnichów z pobliskiego klasztoru Vicovaro, aby został ich przełożonym. Gdy jednak po dość krótkim czasie część wspólnoty zbuntowała się przeciw niemu – odszedł z grupą wiernych sobie uczniów. Jego życie przypadło czas wielkiego kryzysu starożytnej kultury zachodnio-rzymskiej, zniszczonej w znacznym stopniu przez inwazję plemion barbarzyńskich z Północy i Wschodu. Pomimo tego w 529 roku założył klasztor na Monte Cassino, w miejscu dawnej pogańskiej świątyni. Tam właśnie opracował nowy model wspólnoty mniszej, żądając od swoich uczniów potrójnych ślubów: stałości, zachowania obyczajów monastycznych i posłuszeństwa. Święty Benedykt uważał swoją Regułę za drogę dla początkujących, za szkołę służby Bogu, w której nie pragniemy narzucać niczego, co byłoby zbyt ostre lub surowe. Święty Benedykt zmarł 21 marca 547 roku wśród swoich uczniów.

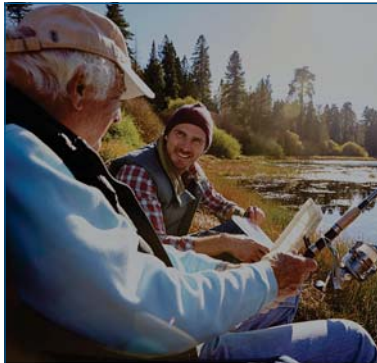

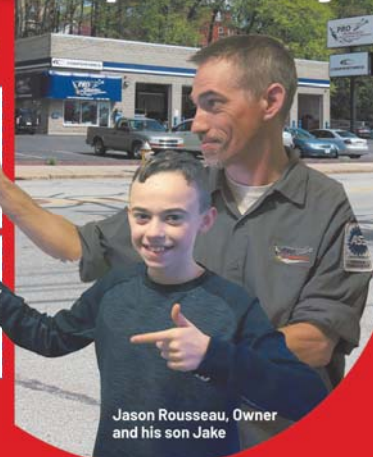
