#### RE- OPENING OF THE BASILICA

Weekend masses will be celebrated at the regular times and accessible for parishioners to attend.

**However, we need to follow certain rules and restrictions:**

- Everyone has to wear a mask.
- All members of the congregation are required to observe a minimum of a 6-foot social distance. (Members living in the same home can sit closer in the pew.) Also a 6-foot distance has to be kept entering and exiting the church.
- Communion will be distributed only in the hand.
- There will be no collection during the Mass. Baskets will be available at the entrances.
- No hymnals will be available in the pews.
- No congregational singing is allowed.
- There will be no offertory procession as well as the entrance and recessional processions.
- No sign of peace.

#### Continuing Suspension of the Sunday Obligation

Because older adults and those with underlying health conditions continue to be advised to avoid public assemblies, the suspension of the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays will remain in force until December 31, 2020.

**Masses will continue to be streamed live for those who are not comfortable to attend in person.**

#### SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Since you are not able to attend Mass physically, you may watch it on TV and receive spiritual communion. Begin by examining your conscience and making a good Act of Contrition. Then pray one of the prayers recommended by the Saints for inviting Christ into your heart. Here is one by Saint Alphonsus Liguori:

*My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love you above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already there, and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.*

#### ST. KATERI TEKAKWITHA

St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the first Native American to be recognized as a saint by the Catholic Church. She was born in 1656, in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon. Her mother was an Algonquin, who was captured by the Mohawks and who took a Mohawk chief for her husband.

She contracted smallpox as a four-year-old child which scarred her skin. The scars were a source of humiliation in her youth. She was commonly seen wearing a blanket to hide her face. Worse, her entire family died during the outbreak. Kateri Tekakwitha was subsequently raised by her uncle, who was the chief of a Mohawk clan.

Kateri was known as a skilled worker, who was diligent and patient. However, she refused to marry. When her adoptive parents proposed a suitor to her, she refused to entertain the proposal. They punished her by giving her more work to do, but she did not give in. Instead, she remained quiet and diligent. Eventually they were forced to relent and accept that she had no interest in marriage.

At age 19, Kateri Tekakwitha converted to Catholicism, taking a vow of chastity and pledging to marry only Jesus Christ. Her decision was very unpopular with her adoptive parents and their neighbors. Some of her neighbors started rumors of sorcery. To avoid persecution, she traveled to a Christian native community south of Montreal.

According to legend, Kateri was very devout and would put thorns on her sleeping mat. She often prayed for the conversion of her fellow Mohawks. According to the Jesuit missionaries that served the community where Kateri lived, she often fasted and when she would eat, she would taint her food to diminish its flavor. On at least one occasion, she burned herself. Such self-mortification was common among the Mohawk.

Kateri was very devout and was known for her steadfast devotion. She was also very sickly. Her practices of self-mortification and denial may not have helped her health. Sadly, just five years after her conversion to Catholicism, she became ill and passed away at age 24, on April 17, 1680.

Her name, Kateri, is the Mohawk form of Catherine, which she took from St. Catherine of Siena.

St. Kateri Tekakwitha was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on Oct. 21, 2012. She is the patroness of ecology and the environment, people in exile, and Native Americans. Her feast day is July 14th.

**CHALLENGING MINDS AND FORMING HEARTS FOR OVER 125 YEARS**

### PIĘTNASTA NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

12 lipca, 2020

*"Ziarno posiane między ciernie oznacza tego, kto słucha słowa, lecz troski doczesne i ułuda bogactwa zagłuszają słowo, tak że zostaje bezowocne." (Mt 13, 22)*



Kiedy byliśmy małymi dziećmi, ekscytowało nas wpłacanie pieniędzy na nasze pierwsze książeczki oszczędnościowe i obserwowanie wzrostu - 20, 40, 75, a w końcu 100! Gdy osiągnęliśmy kolejny poziom, rosła nasza motywacja do oszczędzania i nauczyliśmy się nawyku, który służy nam przez całe życie. Te książeczki były potwierdzeniem naszych finansowych osiągnięć.

Często wierni jak i duchowieństwo osądzają swoje życie i wiarę według wielkości swoich osiągnięć. Komentarze typu „Nigdy nie budowałem kościoła ani szkoły” wydają się unieważniać tysiące chrztów, ślubów lub odwiedzin u chorych. „Nigdy nie zrobiłem nic wielkiego” - a co z setkami zmienionych pieluszek, wychowywaniem dzieci i kształtowaniem młodych umysłów, przygotowywaniem tysięcy posiłków lub niezliczone godziny rad i pocieszenia, sąsiedzkiej troski lub poświęcenia rodzinie, pracy i społeczności? Wielką wiarę mierzy wytrwałość, uczciwość, miłość i wierność. Na początku wydaje się mała i nieistotna. Ale jest solą ziemi dającą życie, smak i wyżywienie wszystkim, którzy jej posmakują. W sprawach duchowych nie daj się zwieść wielkości. Każda drobna rzecz może mieć wpływ na zmianę całego świata.

#### ŚW. KATERI TEKAKWITHA - święto 14 lipca

Św. Kateri jest pierwszą rdzenną Amerykanką, która została uznana przez Kościół katolicki za świętą. Urodziła się w 1656 r. w osadzie Mohawk w Ossernenon. Jej matka należała do plemienia Algonquin. Została schwytana przez plemię Mohawk i wyszła za mąż za ich wodza.

Jako czteroletnie dziecko zachorowała na czarną ospę, która pobiła jej skórę i stała się dla niej źródłem upokorzenia w młodości. Często była widywana ukrywając twarz pod przykryciem. Ponieważ jej rodzina zmarła podczas epidemii, Kateri była wychowywana przez wujka, który był wodzem plemienia Mohawk.

Kateri była znana jako pracowita i cierpliwa osoba, która jednak odmawiała wyjścia za mąż. Kiedy przybrani rodzice zaproponowali jej narzeczonego, stanowczo odmówiła. Choć ją ukarali, dając jej więcej pracy, nie poddała się lecz pozostała cicha i pracowita. W końcu zaakceptowali fakt, że nie była zainteresowana małżeństwem.

W wieku 19 lat Kateri przeszła na katolicyzm składając ślub czystości i obiecując poślubić tylko Jezusa Chrystusa. Jej decyzja była bardzo niepopularna wśród jej przybranych rodziców i sąsiadów. Niektórzy zaczęli plotkować o czarach. Aby uniknąć prześladowań, udała się do chrześcijańskiej społeczności na południe od Montrealu.

Według legendy Kateri była bardzo pobożna i nawet spała na cierniach ułożonych na macie do spania. Często modliła się o nawrócenie przyjaciół z plemienia Mohawk. Według jezuickich misjonarzy, którzy służyli jej wspólnocie, często pościła, a kiedy jadła, starała się, aby osłabić smak jedzenia. Co najmniej raz celowo się poparzyła, co było powszechnym wyrazem umartwiania wśród plemienia Mohawk.

Kateri była bardzo pobożna i znana ze swego niezłomnego oddania. Niestety, była też chorowita, a jej praktyki umartwienia i postu nie pomagały w utrzymaniu zdrowia. Niestety, zaledwie pięć lat po nawróceniu na katolicyzm, zachorowała i zmarła w wieku 24 lat, 17 kwietnia 1680 r.

Jej imię, Kateri, jest indiańską formą Katarzyny, które przyjęła ku czci św. Katarzyny ze Sieny.

Święta Kateri Tekakwitha została kanonizowana przez papieża Benedykta XVI 21.X.2012r. Jest patronką ekologii i środowiska, ludzi na uchodźstwie i rdzennych Amerykanów.

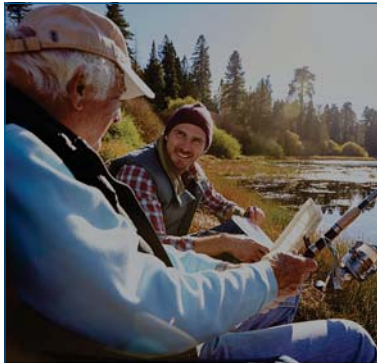

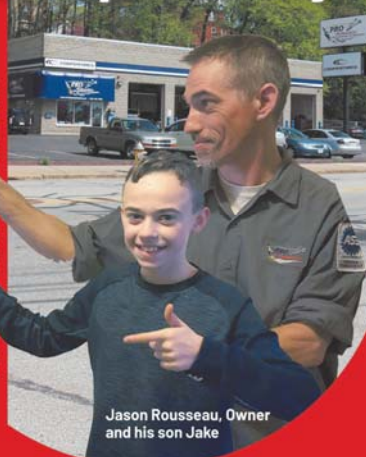
