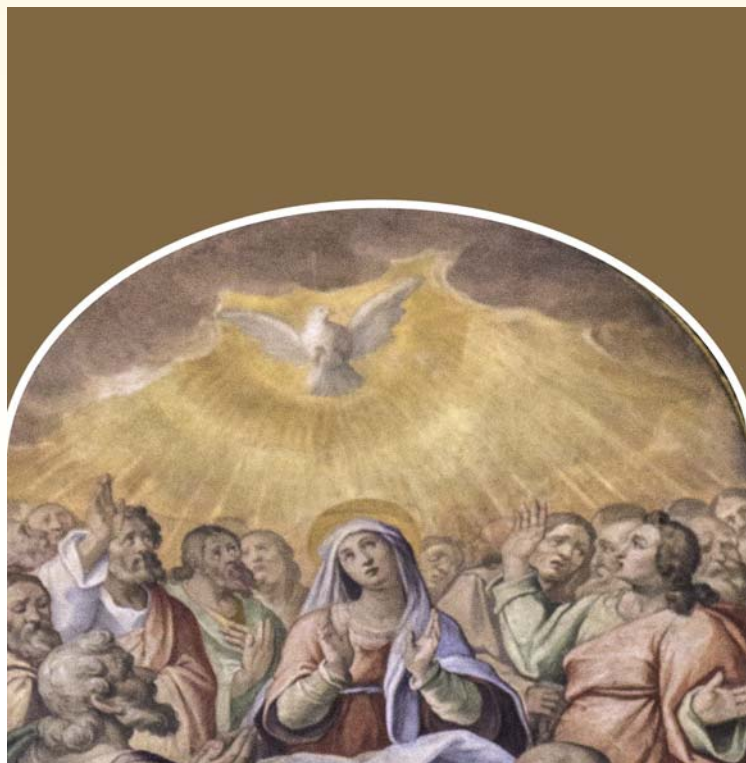

PENTECOST SUNDAY**May 23, 2021**

The students in the Confirmation class did a lot of service hours for our parish and, in the process, discovered quite a bit about themselves and their beliefs. They painted a fence in the cemetery, visited some elderly parishioners with food baskets and small gifts, served meals in the soup kitchen, volunteered as babysitters during Sunday Mass and were servers and cantors and ushers at various times during the year. They learned that the life of the parish centers on the Eucharist, but extends throughout the week to all kinds of people, situations and needs. In turn, they discovered how truly gifted they were and how much the life of the Church depends on them.

At Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descends on the Apostles to strengthen them for the task of spreading the Gospel. In Confirmation, we are given the spiritual gifts we need to fulfill our own mission. RE- OPENING OF THE BASILICA

Weekend masses will be celebrated at the regular times and accessible for parishioners to attend.

However, we need to follow certain rules and restrictions:

- Everyone has to wear a mask.
- All members of the congregation are required to observe a minimum of a 6-foot social distance. (Members living in the same home can sit closer in the pew.) Also a 6-foot distance has to be kept entering and exiting the church.
- Communion will be distributed only in the hand.
- There will be no collection during the Mass. Baskets will be available at the entrances.
- No hymnals will be available in the pews.
- No congregational singing is allowed.
- There will be no offertory procession as well as the entrance and recessional processions.
- No sign of peace.

Continuing Suspension of the Sunday Obligation

Because older adults and those with underlying health conditions continue to be advised to avoid public assemblies, the suspension of the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays will remain in force **until the Solemnity of Pentecost on May 23, 2021. Masses will continue to be streamed live for those who are not comfortable to attend in person.**

SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

Since you are not able to attend Mass physically, you may watch it on TV and receive spiritual communion. Begin by examining your conscience and making a good Act of Contrition. Then pray one of the prayers recommended by the Saints for inviting Christ into your heart. Here is one by Saint Alphonsus Liguori:

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love you above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace you as if you were already there, and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you. Amen.

PENTECOST



This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year that concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church. Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension into heaven. Because Easter is a moveable feast without a fixed date, and Pentecost depends on the timing of Easter, Pentecost can fall anywhere between May 10 and June 13.

The timing of these feasts is also where Catholics get the concept of the Novena - nine days of prayer - because in Acts 1, Mary and the Apostles prayed together "continuously" for nine days after the Ascension leading up to Pentecost. Traditionally, the Church prays the Novena to the Holy Spirit in the days before Pentecost. The name of the day itself is derived from the Greek word "pentecoste," meaning 50th.

On Friday, May 14th, Ms. Kelly Bailey's Fifth Grade students and Mrs. Karen Lefebvre's Sixth Grade Language Arts students presented the Living Wax Museum at St. Joseph School. The Living Wax Museum is an annual two-part project that focuses on reading biographies and presenting their book reports in a unique way. Each student must dress up as the person they are portraying and speak as that person. Key points they need to know include the person's birth date, details about their childhood, and how they contributed to our society.

St. Joseph School students are eligible for an invitation to the National Junior Honor Society at the end of their 6th or 7th Grade academic year. Cumulative Grade Point Averages (GPA) are calculated based on every completed quarter of middle school, starting with the first quarter of 6th Grade. Invitations to complete a Student Information Packet are sent to those with a 3.50 or higher cumulative GPA in the core subjects: Religion, Math, Literature, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, and Spelling. Students must also document their community service hours to be considered for membership.

Membership in the NJHS is a distinction that holds significance throughout a student's academic life. Honor Society students become ambassadors for St. Joseph School and undertake meaningful service projects in the school and the local community. These service projects often become life-changing experiences for members who discover new passions and callings. Members of the St. Joseph School NJHS regularly volunteer at the Webster-Dudley Food Share and St. Joseph Polish Festival and look forward to these opportunities resuming very soon. 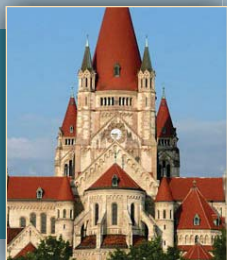
