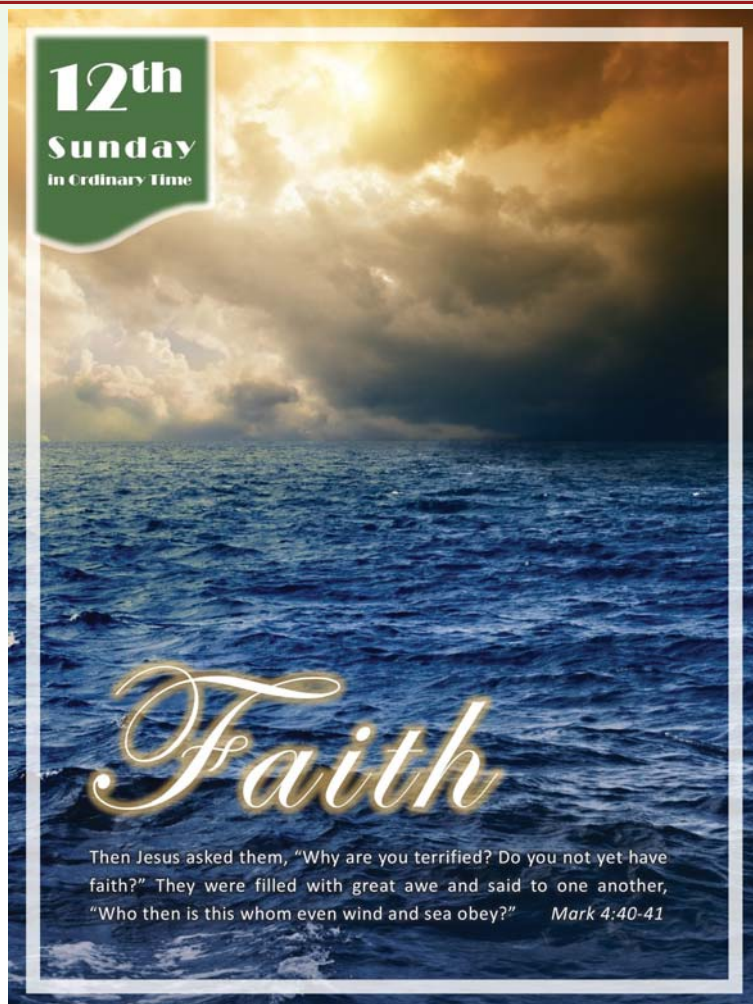

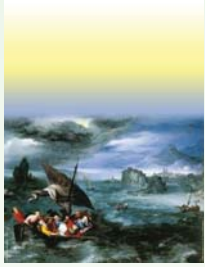

EFFECTIVE MAY 29, 2021

RESTRICTIONS WILL BE LIFTED IN OUR BASILICA

Please note the following:

- The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation will be effective June 6, 2021, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.
- All limitations concerning the size of gatherings in non-liturgical spaces have been lifted.
- Masks and social distancing are no longer required of all parishioners. However per CDC guidelines, non-vaccinated persons, including minors, are still encouraged to wear masks and maintain social distancing.
- All entrances of the Basilica will be open. Holy Water will be available by dispensers located at the entrances of the Basilica.
- The singing of Hymns and acclamation will be restored.
- Entrance, Recessional and Offertory processions will be restored.
- The exchange of the Sign of Peace **will not** be practiced until the number of COVID-19 cases have fallen to a lower level.
- The Sacrament of Penance in the traditional confessionals will be resumed.
- Holy Communion will be distributed in the customary, pre-pandemic manner.

THE NATIVITY OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST



Jesus said, "Among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist" (Mt. 11:11). Each year on June 24 the Catholic Church honors the birth of John by reflecting on his unique role as the precursor of Jesus. The solemnity held on that date praises John as a worthy example of what it means to be a follower of Christ.

A solemnity is the most significant feast the Church can establish. While other saints are remembered with feast days to remember their deaths, St. John the Baptist, like Our Lady, is honored with solemnities to recall both his birth and his death.

June 24 was chosen as the date for the solemnity because Scripture tells us that John was conceived six months before Jesus (see Lk 1:36). Presumably, then, John was born about six months before Christ, and Christ's nativity was celebrated on Christmas Eve, December 24. John the Baptist provided a model of heroic holiness. He challenged the greed and materialism of his day, following a life of poverty, simplicity and selflessness.

John's message to the people so many years ago was that the Lord is imminent, so we must be prepared. On the solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, the Church renews that message.



Festival, Food, Family, and Fund 2021 Fundraiser Kicks-Off This Weekend! As we are aware, Festival48 is canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Festival raises significant funds for St. Joseph School and the proceeds directly benefit our students. Therefore, like last year, we will kick-off a Virtual Giving Event on Father's Day Weekend – the three days that would have been Festival48 so the school can maintain its high standard of education by providing a well-rounded curriculum to our students.

The goal of our Festival, Food, Family, and Fund 2021 Fundraiser is to raise \$20,000; the amount needed to upgrade our Social Studies curriculum for our Kindergarten through 8th-grade students.

Social Studies is the integrated study of multiple fields of social science and the humanities including history, geography, and political science. By upgrading our Social Studies curriculum and integrating faith and Gospel values into a St. Joseph School education, we will help our students develop the ability to make informed, reasoned, and moral decisions for the public good. We believe this is especially important and a much-needed part of the St. Joseph School experience and the foundation we provide our students.

Although we realize that this may be a difficult time for many, we ask that you consider donating the amount you would have spent at Festival48 to The Fund for St. Joseph School. This amount may be as little as \$15 - the cost of a Polish Platter. Any amount – large or small – assists in sustaining the educational ministry of St. Joseph School. St. Joseph School is proud to announce that Fourth-Grade student Gianna Pigeon has been selected as the Grand Prize winner in Emmanuel Radio's 2021 Catholic Schools Essay Contest. This year's contest theme was "The Year of St. Joseph." Over 6,000 students from 23 schools throughout the Diocese of Worcester participated in the contest.

Gianna was initially selected as a weekly winner in late April. At that time, Emmanuel Radio traveled to St. Joseph School to honor Gianna and award her for her moving essay. In her paper, she detailed how she placed prayers under a statue of St. Joseph every day, asking for his intercession to protect and heal her mother during 20-hour life-saving brain surgery. The sleeping St. Joseph statue was given to Gianna by her teacher, Sr. Jeanne Marie Akalski, who instructed her to pray to St. Joseph and trust him as the protector of families. Gianna's faith and devotion paid off because her prayers were answered, and

her Mom was saved and is doing well.



Then on June 9th, Emmanuel Radio's Cindy Dorsey along with the Superintendent of Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Worcester, Dr. David Perda, St. Joseph School Principal, Michael Hackenson, and Rector & Pastor at St. Joseph Basilica Rev. Grzegorz Chodkowski paid a surprise visit to Sr. Jeanne's class. The purpose of the visit was to announce the Grand Prize winner in Emmanuel Radio's annual Catholic Schools Essay Contest. Gianna's face was filled with tears when she saw her mother, Leah Belanger, and grandmother, Cindy Belanger, enter the classroom and realized she was the winner.

When recognizing Gianna, Dr. Perda emphasized the power of prayer and encouraged all the Fourth-Grade students to remember Gianna's experience so they can testify and inspire others during difficult times. In addition, Sr. Jeanne recognized Gianna and her entire class for getting prayer into their families. However, Mrs. Dorsey received the most fantastic response from the students when she asked, "How many people believe they witnessed a miracle?" All the students responded with cheers and applause. The morning culminated with a special award for Gianna, including a certificate and St. Gianna pendant, as well as a moment to recognize Sr. Jeanne for bringing the theme of sleeping St. Joseph to life through her teaching. Finally, the entire class enjoyed a special breakfast courtesy of Emmanuel Radio. Congratulations to Gianna and her Fourth-Grade classmates for being such remarkable disciples of God.

Niewiele wciąż rozumieją, albo nic, z tego, co Jezus do nich mówił. Ucisza więc burzę i zadaje pytanie w tym rozdziale najważniejsze: Czemu się boicie? Odsłania ich brak wiary. A dla nas? Kim On jest właściwie, że nawet wicher i jezioro są Mu posłuszne?

ŚW. JAN CHRZCICIEL

Św. Jan Chrzciel urodził się między 6 a 2 r. p.n.e. Przez wiele lat św. Jan był pustelnikiem, a to jako prorok, który wzywał do nawrócenia. Udzielał chrztu w Jordanie. Cel chrztu był jeden, a mianowicie przygotowanie osoby do nawrócenia. Chrzt z rąk Jana przyjął także Jezus. Teologowie tłumaczą, że w ten sposób Mesjasz dokonał uświęcenia wody w Jordanie. Dzięki temu woda służy do chrztu świętego, czyli sakramentu, który jest pierwszym i najważniejszym sakramentem dla chrześcijan.

Przyjmuje się, i słusznie, że Jan Chrzciel był obrońcą małżeństwa. Był bowiem tym, który skarcił samego władcę, Heroda, za cudzołóstwo, a ściślej związek z żoną jego brata. Potępiał ten związek publicznie. Za tę śmiałą obronę trwałości małżeństwa i czystości obyczajów został skazany na śmierć męczeńską. Jan Chrzciel został ścięty, a jego głowę, zgodnie z obietnicą Heroda, podano na tacy jego nałożnicy, czego sama się domagała. Natomiast Jezus Chrystus stwierdza na temat Jana Chrzciela, że między narodzonymi z niewiast nie było dotąd większego człowieka od Jana Chrzciela. Jan Chrzciel zmarł ok. 32 r. n.e.

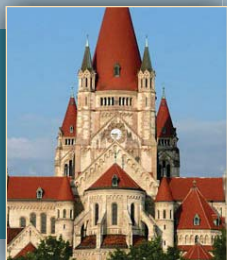
