

### **EFFECTIVE MAY 29, 2021 RESTRICTIONS LIFTED IN OUR BASILICA**

Please note the following:

- The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation will be effective June 6, 2021, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.
- All limitations concerning the size of gatherings in non-liturgical spaces have been lifted.
- Masks and social distancing are no longer required of all parishioners. However per CDC guidelines, non-vaccinated persons, including minors, are still encouraged to wear masks and maintain social distancing.
- All entrances of the Basilica will be open. Holy Water will be available by dispensers located at the entrances of the Basilica.
- The singing of Hymns and acclamation will be restored.
- Entrance, Recessional and Offertory processions will be restored.
- The exchange of the Sign of Peace **will not** be practiced until the number of COVID-19 cases have fallen to a lower level.
- The Sacrament of Penance in the traditional confessionals will be resumed.
- Holy Communion will be distributed in the customary, pre-pandemic manner.

### **BEATIFICATION OF CARDINAL STEFAN WYSZYŃSKI**

The beatification of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński, the former Primate of Poland who heroically resisted communism, will take place on Sunday, Sept. 12.

Cardinal Kazimierz Nycz announced April 23 that the beatification ceremony would be held in the Polish capital, Warsaw, at noon local time.

Nycz, the archbishop of Warsaw, said that Wyszyński would be beatified alongside Sr. Róża Maria Czacka, a Polish nun who died in 1961 after a lifetime of service to blind people.



“During the September ceremony, Pope Francis will be represented by Cardinal Marcello Semeraro, prefect of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, who will

promulgate the decree of beatification,” he said in a statement.

Nycz announced last April that Wyszyński’s beatification, originally scheduled for June 7, 2020, in Warsaw’s Piłsudski Square, had been postponed indefinitely because of the coronavirus crisis.

“A pandemic threatening the health and life of people makes it impossible to prepare and carry out this ceremony,” he said at the time. “The first priority must be concern for human safety.”

Wyszyński is credited with helping to preserve and strengthen Christianity in Poland despite the communist regime’s persecution from 1945 onwards.

He is known as the “Primate of the Millennium” because as Primate of Poland he oversaw a nine-year program of preparation culminating in a nationwide celebration of the millennium of Poland’s baptism in 1966.

In 1953, Wyszyński was placed under house arrest by Communist authorities for three years for refusing to punish priests active in the Polish resistance against the Communist regime.

He also helped to secure the approval of Karol Wojtyła as archbishop of Kraków in 1964, which ultimately led to Wojtyła’s election as Pope John Paul II in 1978.

Wyszyński died on May 28, 1981, 15 days after Pope John Paul II was shot in an assassination attempt. Unable to attend the cardinal’s funeral, John Paul II wrote in a letter to the people of Poland: “Meditate particularly on the figure of the unforgettable primate, Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński of venerated memory, his person, his teaching, his role in such a difficult period of our history.”


The Vatican announced the approval of a miracle attributed to Wyszyński’s intercession last October.

The miracle involved the healing of a 19-year-old woman from thyroid cancer in 1989. After the young woman received the incurable diagnosis, a group of Polish nuns began praying for her healing through the intercession of Wyszyński, who died of abdominal cancer.

The Polish parliament declared 2021 the Year of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński, in anticipation of his beatification.

In his statement on Friday, Nycz said: “The organizing committee is resuming its work and will soon provide further details regarding the organization of the beatification ceremony.”

*“I express my gratitude to the Holy Father, Francis, for setting the date of the beatification. I ask all the faithful to pray for the blessed fruits of the beatification of the Servants of God, Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński and Sr. Róża Maria Czacka.”*

**Bóg zapłać!****Beatyfikacja Kardynała Stefana Wyszyńskiego  
- Prymasa Tysiąclecia**

Beatyfikacja Kardynała Stefana Wyszyńskiego, byłego Prymasa Polski, który bohatersko oparł się komunizmowi, odbędzie się w niedzielę 12 września. Arcybiskup Kazimierz Nycz zapowiedział, że ceremonia beatyfikacyjna odbędzie się w stolicy Polski, Warszawie, w południe czasu lokalnego. Arc. Nycz zapowiedział, że Kard. Wyszyński zostanie beatyfikowany wraz z s. Różą Marią Czacką, polską zakonnicą, która zmarła w

1961 roku po wieloletniej służbie niewidomym. Podczas wrześniowej ceremonii papieża Franciszka będzie reprezentował kardynał Marcello Semeraro, prefekt Kongregacji Spraw Kanonizacyjnych, który ogłosił dekret o beatyfikacji. Arc. Nycz poinformował w kwietniu, że beatyfikacja Kard. Wyszyńskiego, pierwotnie zaplanowana na 7 czerwca 2020 r. na warszawskim Placu Piłsudskiego, została przełożona na czas nieokreślony z powodu kryzysu związanego z koronawirusem.

Kard. Wyszyńskiemu przypisuje się pomoc w zachowaniu i umacnianiu chrześcijaństwa w Polsce pomimo prześladowań ze strony reżimu komunistycznego od 1945 roku.

Znany jest jako „Prymas Tysiąclecia”, ponieważ jako Prymas Polski nadzorował 9-letni program przygotowań, którego kulminacją było ogólnopolskie świętowanie tysiąclecia Chrztu Polski w 1966 roku.

W 1953 r. Kard. Wyszyński został umieszczony przez władze komunistyczne na trzy lata w areszcie domowym za odmowę ukarania księży działających w polskim ruchu oporu przeciwko reżimowi komunistycznemu.

Pomógł także uzyskać aprobatę Karola Wojtyły na arcybiskupa Krakowa w 1964 roku, co ostatecznie doprowadziło do wyboru Wojtyły na papieża Jana Pawła II w 1978 roku. Kard. Wyszyński zmarł 28 maja 1981 r., 15 dni po zamachu na papieża Jana Pawła II. Nie mogąc przybyć na pogrzeb kardynała, Jan Paweł II napisał w liście do Polaków: „Medytuj szczególnie nad postacią niezapomnianego prymasa czczonej pamięci kard. Stefana Wyszyńskiego, jego osoby, jego nauczania, jego roli w tak trudnym okresie naszej historii.”

Watykan ogłosił aprobatę cudu przypisywanego wstawiennictwu Kard. Wyszyńskiego w październiku ubiegłego roku. Cudem było uzdrowienie 19-letniej kobiety z raka tarczycy w 1989 roku. Po otrzymaniu nieuleczalnej diagnozy, grupa polskich zakonnic zaczęła modlić się o jej uzdrowienie za wstawiennictwem Kard. Wyszyńskiego, który zmarł na nowotwór jamy brzusznej.

W swoim oświadczeniu w piątek Arc. Nycz powiedział: „Komitet organizacyjny wznawia pracę i wkrótce przedstawi dalsze szczegóły dotyczące organizacji uroczystości beatyfikacyjnej”.

„Wyrażam wdzięczność Ojcu Świętemu Franciszkowi za wyznaczenie daty beatyfikacji. Wszystkich wiernych proszę o modlitwę o błogosławione owoce beatyfikacji Sług Bożych Kardynała Stefana Wyszyńskiego oraz Siostry Róży Marii Czackiej”.


