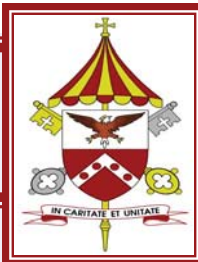
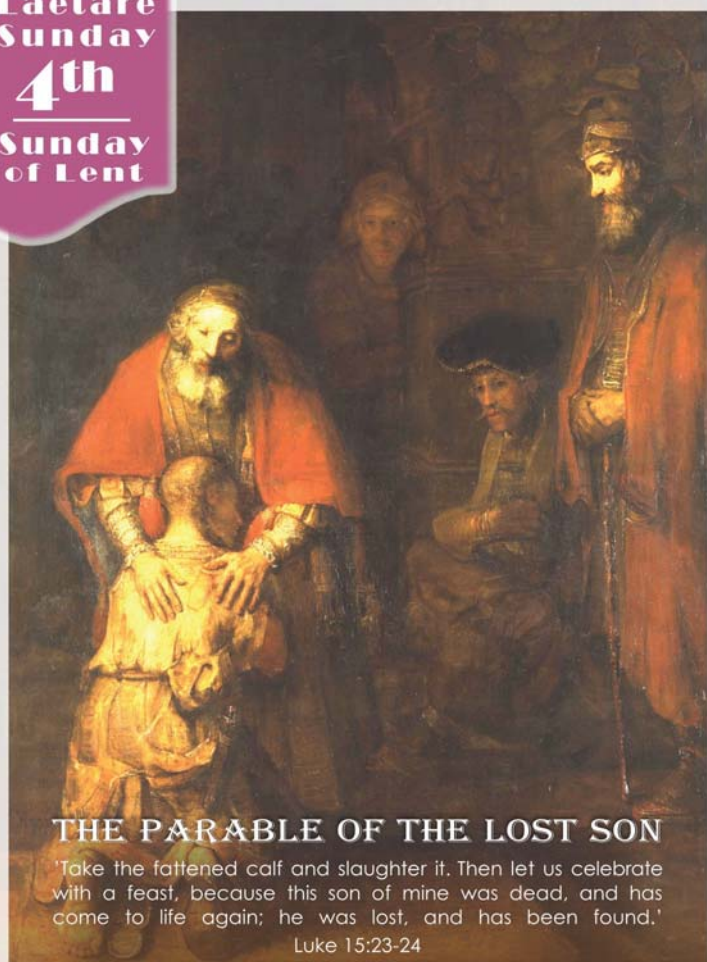

Has there ever been a time when we did not need forgiveness? Haven't we all gotten a little off course—with God, with our family, or with our friends—at one time or another? Isn't there always someone who we should forgive? Here are a few thoughts about forgiveness, inspired by the Prodigal Son and his brother.

To forgive does not require that we forget. After all, if it were easy to forget, would we need to forgive? When you forgive, you free a person who is a prisoner of anger and hate. Then you realize that the person freed is you. Ordinary people have offered forgiveness in extraordinary circumstances. We can learn from their courage and example. Those who are the most difficult to forgive are often the ones who need it the most. Forgiveness brings peace, contentment, hope and calm. Be forgiving of others. They may be fighting a spiritual battle much larger than yours. If you forgive others, God will forgive you. If you knew the life of even your worst enemy, you would find sorrow, fear and suffering that would move you to forgive any and all hurts. Understanding opens the door to forgiveness. Ask for forgiveness as soon as you can. Waiting only makes the hurt grow stronger. Celebrate the healing and joy of those who are forgiven. One day, that party will be for you!

NOVENA TO DIVINE MERCY



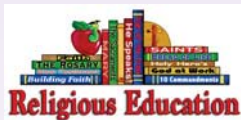

St. Joseph School National Junior Honor Society Members: Serving their Fellow Students and Beyond!

On Thursday, March 18th, in the spirit of solidarity with the victims of the war in Ukraine, members of the St. Joseph School Eagles Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) were present at the morning drop-off to collect monetary donations from families. The students arrived at 7:00 am to greet every family as they arrived at the school. Although it was a rainy day and the collection only lasted one hour, the students raised over \$1,000 for their cause. They took the endeavor very seriously because several people in the St. Joseph School and Parish communities have family and friends in Poland affected by the war. Several of them are welcoming refugees into their homes. For this reason, the proceeds will be donated to Caritas Polska. However, the collection to benefit the victims of the war in Ukraine is not the only service the students have performed this year.

The NJHS students also feel strongly about the academic and spiritual foundation they receive while attending St. Joseph School and make it their goal to help share this experience with others. During the Advent season, the chapter conducted a Christmas Stocking Raffle as its 2021 winter community service project and presented the proceeds, \$100 for fuel assistance for needy members of the community and \$100 to the St. Joseph School Scholarship Fund for tuition assistance, to Principal Beth Boudreau.

In addition, the group recently answered a call for help from the Sleeping Bag Ministry at the United Church of Christ, Federated in Webster. After seeing an article in a local paper requesting items to make sleeping bags and health kits for the homeless, the NJHS students organized a school-wide collection. First, they collected mittens, gloves, soap, toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, hand lotion, tissues from their classmates, and neckties to secure the contents in the sleeping bags. Then, the students and their advisor Seventh Grade Instructor Karen Lefebvre, Principal Beth Boudreau, and Headmaster Rev. Grzegorz Chodkowski, delivered the items to the dedicated women known as the Golden Bees. During their visit, the students had the opportunity to meet program director Edna Patri and Pastor Ann Gilbert. During their visit, the NJHS members learned how the sleeping bags are made and that they are distributed throughout New England.

The members are evident in the school. They tutor younger students and help maintain the school grounds. In addition, the NJHS students are expected to demonstrate good citizenship and be of excellent character. Their service projects exemplify these qualities, which often become life-changing experiences for members who discover new passions and callings. The St. Joseph School NJHS includes Seventh Grade Students Emerson Bernard, Leah Boudreau, Haleigh Creighton, Gabriela Pianka, Shayley Szela, Vanessa Zeglen, and Eighth Grade Students Andrew Bergeron and Gianna DiCola-Keddy. Great job, students!

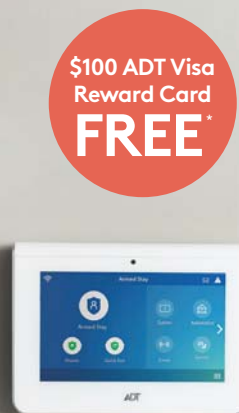
