In 1955, a husband and wife songwriting team attended a youth retreat in California. They put together a song that captured their hopes for a better, more peaceful world. On June 2nd, the Most Rev. Robert Joseph McManus, Bishop of the Diocese of Worcester, and Dr. David Perda, superintendent of the Diocese of Worcester, witnessed the zeal of the fourth grade class of Saint Joseph School when they attended the school's first religion bee competition. All participants were winners for the day since each received a Bible, a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and a medal engraved with the Bible and praying hands. The fourth graders also enjoyed a pizza lunch after the bee.



The idea of a religion bee originated during Catholic Schools Week when the fourth-grade teacher, Sister Jeanne Marie Akalski, challenged the students to learn the rudiments of faith by studying the Saint Joseph Edition of the Baltimore Catechism. Jezus zachęca nas do głoszenia słowa bez obciążeń, które utrudniają misję. Wszystko, co skupia niepotrzebnie naszą uwagę lub marnuje energię robotnika, powinno być odrzucone. Najważniejszy jest cel misji, czyli obfite głoszenie słowa.

Niesamowicie istotną rzeczą jest też szacunek dla wolnej woli słuchacza. Musimy mieć świadomość, że każdy człowiek ma inny czas dojrzewania w wierze i w przyjęciu słowa lub, że niestety może je odrzucić. Jeśli z wiarą wypełniamy wolę Bożą, cieszymy się, że nasze imiona zapisane są w niebie, w Księdze Życia, jak to określa Apokalipsa.

I chce, abyśmy poznali, że Jego miłosierdzie jest większe niż nasze grzechy, abyśmy mogli wzywać Go z ufnością, przyjął Jego miłosierdzie i pozwolić, by płynęło przez nas do innych. W ten sposób wszyscy przyjdą, aby dzielić Jego radość. Przesłanie Bożego Miłosierdzia możemy przywołać na myśl, pamiętając o tym:

- **Proś o Jego Miłosierdzie.** Bóg chce, abyśmy nieustannie zbliżali się do Niego w modlitwie, żałując za nasze grzechy i prosząc Go, aby przelał swoje miłosierdzie na nas i na cały świat.
- **Bądź miłosierny.** Bóg chce, abyśmy przyjęli Jego miłosierdzie i przekazali je innym. On chce, abyśmy przekazywali innym miłość i przebaczenie, tak jak On przekazuje nam.
- **Całkowicie zaufaj Jezusowi.** Bóg chce, abyśmy wiedzieli, że łaski Jego miłosierdzia zależą od naszego zaufania. Im bardziej ufamy Jezusowi, tym więcej otrzymamy.

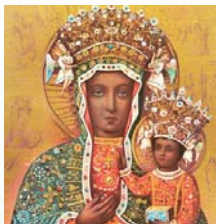
