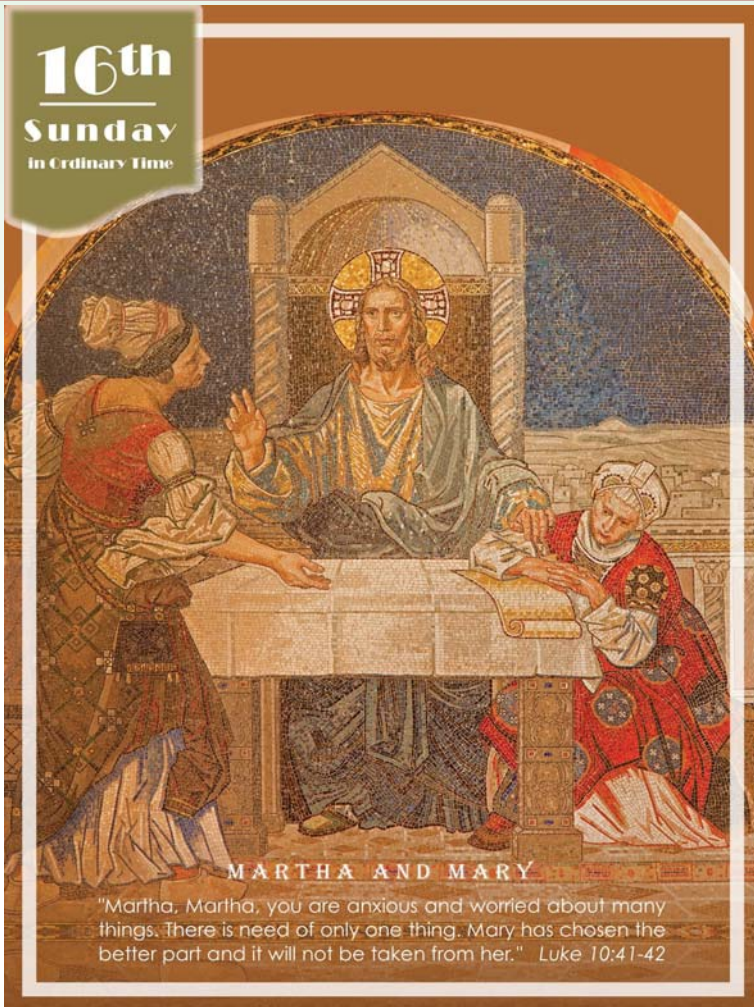

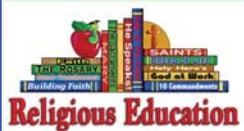


**MEN OF ST. JOSEPH INTERNATIONAL

ORGAN CONCERT PROGRAM, JULY 31 AT 11:30 AM

On July 31, we will have the opportunity to listen to a vocal-instrumental concert. The program will primarily include organ music from various eras. Among them you will hear works from an 18th-century manuscript found in the convent of Poor Clares in Stary Sącz, 20th-century Polish music by Marian Sawa, virtuoso organ music by the greatest baroque composer of all time Johann Sebastian Bach, as well as French 19th and 20th century composers such as, Louis James Alfred Lefébure-Wély and Eugène Gigout. There will also be works for singing connoisseurs, i.e. Felix Mendelssohn-Bartholdy's compositions. There will be duets, including Ave Maria, and Ecce panis angelorum in Latin. There will also be singing in Polish, to the music of Franz Schubert, or popular, contemporary Polish religious singing.

Performers: **Mirosława Cieślak**, an excellent Polish organist who gives concerts in many countries, lives permanently in Germany, having a number of international competitions, album and studio recordings behind her; **Dietmar Rönnecke**, concert tenor living in Germany; **Maria Helena Czarnecka Cieślak**, Polish organist and vocalist, graduate of the Catholic University of Lublin, organist at the Cathedral of Radom and the Basilica of St. Joseph in Webster, MA.

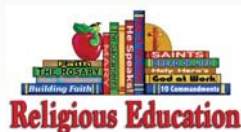
