20TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME AUGUST 14, 2022

*"Do you think I have come to give you peace on Earth? No, I tell you, but rather division."
LUKE 12:51*



In this week's Gospel, Jesus uses the image of fire to describe the demands of discipleship. The fire he has come to cast on the earth is the fire that he wants to blaze in each of our hearts. He made us from the dust of the earth, and filled us with the fire of the Holy Spirit in baptism. We were baptized into his death. This is the baptism our Lord speaks of in the Gospel this week. The baptism with which He must be baptized is His passion and death, by which He accomplished our redemption and sent forth the fire of the Spirit on the earth. The fire has been set, but it is not yet blazing.

We are called to enter deeper into the consuming love of God. We must examine our consciences and our actions, submitting ourselves to the revealing fire of God's Word. In our struggle against sin, we have not yet resisted to the point of shedding our own blood, Paul tells us in this week's Epistle. We have not undergone the suffering that Jeremiah suffers in the First Reading this week. But this is what true discipleship requires. To be a disciple is to be inflamed with the love of God. It is to have an unquenchable desire for holiness and zeal for the salvation of our brothers and sisters. Being His disciple does not bring peace in the false way that the world proclaims peace. It means division and hardship. It may bring us to conflict with our own flesh and blood. But Christ is our peace. By his cross, he has lifted us up from the mire of sin and death—as he will rescue the prophet Jeremiah.

On Monday, August 15, we celebrate the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God.

Assumption Day is considered a Holy Day of Obligation, but if it falls on a Saturday or on a Monday, it is not obligatory by the church to attend mass. This was amended in the church calendar by US (United States) bishops in 1991.

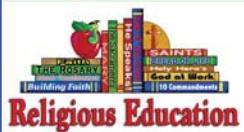

SECOND COLLECTION - AUGUST 21 CHURCH IN CENTRAL & EASTERN EUROPE

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

On February 24, Russia initiated military action against Ukraine with attacks throughout the country, including in the capital city, Kyiv. Major Archbishop of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in Kyiv, Sviatoslav Shevchuk, appealed for prayers for the peace and safety of the Ukrainian people, reminding everyone to place hope in Christ, that *"after night, there comes day...after darkness, there comes light, just as after death there comes resurrection."*

The Church in Ukraine is helping to share and foster this hope even amidst this violence. Though curfews keep the faithful from gathering in churches, "the Church will come to the people" by continuing to celebrate Mass and provide the Sacraments in bomb shelters and underground stations.

Pope Francis has called upon the Universal Church to pray and fast especially for peace in Ukraine. Catholics in the U.S. can also show their solidarity by participating in the annual **Collection for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe (CCEE)**. The collection will help the Church in Ukraine bring the light of Christ to the faithful affected by the darkness of war, violence, and loss of families and homes and provide other essential funding in the region. Your support of this collection is a tangible way of assisting the Church's response and outreach to those affected and displaced by the violence.

CCEE will be taken up in our diocese on the weekend of August 14. In addition to supporting relief efforts in the Ukraine, the collection also strengthens Catholic education, charitable programs and development of new lay leaders in 27 other countries which were subject for many decades to Communist regimes.

The 'ŚLASK' Song and Dance Ensemble was founded on July 1, 1953. It owes its exceptional nature to its founder and initiator, Stanisław Hadyna, a Silesian composer and literary scholar. The Ensemble is named after the Silesia region ('Ślask' in Polish), and the name of its founder to commemorate his undeniable contribution to the greatness of 'ŚLASK' and acclaimed position it has earned over the years. For decades, the Ensemble strove for perfection and mastery.

Today, it is a cultural institution with great executive capabilities, performing around 120 concerts a year.

The quintessence of the Ensemble's artistic activity is the gala concerts performed by the group which are characterised by the liveliness, expression and professionalism of the Ensemble's artistic composition, featuring over 100 performers in the choir, ballet and orchestra.

The dynamic nature of gala concerts and their colourful stage costumes create a spectacle that takes the audience on a journey to the world of picturesque folk culture.

Since May 2017, the 'ŚLASK' Ensemble has been the Cultural Institution of the Government of the Silesian Voivodeship co-managed by the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage. The headquarters of the Ensemble is the historic Palace and Park Complex in Koszęcin, one of the largest palace complexes of the period of neoclassicism in Poland, entered in the register of historic monuments. Być może konflikt wcale nie jest takim przekleństwem, jak nam się wydaje. Czasem konflikt, otwarty konflikt, bywa lepszy niż fałszywy pokój. O ile bowiem fałszywy pokój polega na omijaniu trudnych tematów, przemilczaniu tego, co ważne, udawaniu, że nic nas nie dzieli, dla zachowania świętego spokoju, a więc pewnego marazmu, o tyle konflikt może w niektórych sytuacjach być twórczy. Jeśli kłócimy się z tymi, których kochamy, to dlatego, że są sprawy, na których bardzo nam zależy, sprawy ważniejsze od świętego spokoju, ważniejsze niż psychiczny komfort. Konflikt bywa bardzo motywujący, pozwala sprecyzować swoje stanowisko i uniknąć zamykania spraw pod dywan. Jeśli więc nawet nastąpi pewnego rodzaju rozłam, to także po to, by na jaw wyszła prawda o naszych sercach. Dopiero wobec tej prawdy nastąpić może nawrócenie, dopiero po ujawnieniu się prawdy gotowi będziemy przyjąć pokój, który jest darem Ducha Świętego.
