

Many people claim to be spiritual, but not religious. They acknowledge a spiritual reality, but it is often non-personal and non-specific. It does not involve church or community and resembles a 'feel good' pep talk rather than anything with the power to transform, change and bless. Being spiritual is noncommittal and easy; being religious requires something more personal and committed.

Jesus is not one to tiptoe around the question of faith and commitment. He does not suggest that discipleship is about feeling good or being happy. To follow Him, you pick up a cross. You sacrifice yourself for the sake of others. You follow Him wherever He goes. All this is done with hope in His promise of life and grace.

The quick way to decide if you are spiritual or religious is to answer the question that Jesus asks: Who do you say that I am? If you say He is a nice guy who preached about love, you are spiritual. If you say he is the Son of God who died for our sakes and rose from the dead and sits at the right hand of the Father, and He guides and directs my life through the Holy Spirit and through the Church, then you are religious. Look at the cross, and decide what your answer will be.

THE PASSION OF JOHN THE BAPTIST - AUGUST 29



St. John the Baptist died approximately A.D. 30. He was the cousin of Jesus, the son of St. Elizabeth, and also the nephew of Our Lady.

According to the Gospels, Herod was the one who had arrested and imprisoned John because he spoke out about Herod divorcing his wife, and unlawfully marrying the wife of his brother. Herod feared John, knowing him to be a righteous and holy man, and kept him in custody. When he heard him speak he was

very much perplexed, yet he liked to listen to him.

On Herod's birthday, his new wife's daughter danced before the king and his guests. Her dancing pleased Herod so much that he promised to give her anything she desired. When the daughter asked her mother what she should ask for, she was told to ask for the head of John the Baptist on a platter. Herod was appalled by the request but because of his oath and the guests, he agreed and had John the Baptist executed in prison. St. John the Baptist was beheaded, and his head was placed on a platter and given to Herod's daughter.

When the disciples heard about it, they came and took his body and laid it in a tomb.

St. John the Baptist spoke the truth with great courage in calling others to a true change of heart, and to embrace the ways of God. He did this not only by preaching, but also by example. He fasted in the desert, and prepared the way for Jesus. He had such great courage, that he wasn't fearful of speaking out about the immoral activities of his day.



DWUDZIESTA PIERWSZA NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA

27 sierpnia, 2023

"Lub kto Go pierwszy obdarował, aby nawzajem otrzymać odpłatę?" (Rz 11, 35)



Pan Jezus zadaje uczniom to zasadnicze pytanie w miejscu nieprzypadkowym. Okolice Cezarei Filipowej to północny kraniec Galilei, miejsce kultu bożków i występowania licznych świątyń pogańskich. Odpowiedź na to pytanie akurat w tym miejscu, musiała być zupełnie nieoczywista. Gdyby padło ono np. w Jerozolimie, lub w jej pobliżu, narzucała by się automatycznie odpowiedź nawiązująca do wiary Izraelitów. Tam być może odpowiedź «Ty jesteś Mesjasz», była by wręcz automatyczna. Z drugiej zaś strony, może w bezpośredniej bliskości Świątyni Jerozolimskiej, symbolu wiary Izraela i kultycznym miejscu

obecności Jedynego Boga, trudniej było by o brawurowe w swej nowości wyznanie «Ty jesteś (...) Syn Boga żywego». To oddalone miejsce, pełne praktykowanego tam wielobóstwa, sprzyjało pytaniu nie o katechizmową wiedzę, teorię, ale o

bardzo osobiste doświadczenie i refleksję będącą zajęciem stanowiska.

Żyjąc w czasach Kościoła, dwa tysiące lat po Chrystusie, mamy całe objawienie Boga podane jak na tacy. Nie musimy zmagać się z tym, co dla współczesnych Jezusowi, było porażającą nowością, wszystko mamy opisane, wytłumaczone, znane może od wczesnego dzieciństwa. Jeśli jednak nie zmierzymy się z osobistą odpowiedzią własnego serca, na pytanie postawione uczniom, będziemy tylko teoretykami, ideologami religii chrześcijańskiej. Kim jest dla mnie Jezus Chrystus?


