

"Well done, my good and faithful servant. Since you have been faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities." - MATTHEW 25:21



To help students appreciate each other, a teacher asked her class to write down on a piece of paper a talent or positive quality about each classmate. She then presented each student with the list of things his or her classmates had written. The recognition and affirmation the students received transformed the class into a community of friends. Years later, many of those students still have the list, and consider it one of the life changing moments in their education.

The Gospel today talks about talents and certainly many homilies will focus on the importance of using those gifts for the benefit of others. So today might be a good time to do a little personal inventory. We take our talents for granted, often dismissing them as 'no big deal' or 'everyone can do that.' But no two people use even the same talents in the same way. What are your talents and how do you contribute to your family? Ask your family to do the same thing and then share the results.

Figure out specific ways that each person can express their gifts. By acknowledging each other's uniqueness, we can strengthen our relationships and be transformed into a community of friends.

TRZYDZIESTA TRZECIA NIEDZIELA ZWYKŁA 19 listopada, 2023

"Dobrze, sługo dobry i wierny! Byłeś wierny w rzeczach niewielu, nad wieloma cię postawię: wejdź do radości twego pana!" (Mt 25, 21)



Ze stworzonego przez Mistrza obrazu łatwo zauważyć, że Bóg udzielając Swej łaski oczekuje współpracy i zaangażowania każdego nawet najskromniej obdarowanego nią człowieka. Każdy z nas zachęcany jest więc do czujnej gotowości w wypełnianiu woli Bożej wyrażającej się i w pracy nad samym sobą, i w efektywnym, i zgodnym z Bożym planem wykorzystaniu posiadanych zdolności i umiejętności. Ze słów Chrystusa wynika jednoznacznie, że nawet osoba najmniej uzdolniona i najskromniej obdarzona 'talentami' ma szansę, a zarazem obowiązek, je pomnożyć. Nawet jeśli obawia się czynić tego samodzielnie to zawsze jest to możliwe w twórczej współpracy z innymi. Warto tu także nadmienić, że choć w czasach współczesnych Jezusowi uznawane za moralnie dopuszczalne odsetki bankierskie były dość wysokie i mogły wynosić do 12% rocznie, to słów o 'powierzaniu pieniędzy bankierom' nie należy rozumieć wprost, a więc jako zachęty do lichwy

i spekulacji finansowych, a jako przenośnię pokaźującą słuchaczom, że trudno jest znaleźć usprawiedliwienie dla, jakże częstych także i w dzisiejszych czasach, duchowego lenistwa i bezczynności.

Dzisiejsza druga kolekta jest przeznaczona na Catholic Campaign for Human Development.
