

#### EPIPHANY OF THE LORD January 7, 2024

"They fell down and worshipped him. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh." (Matthew 2:11)

#### **EPIPHANY CHALK**

Today we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany. Epiphany is a celebration of God manifesting as the baby Jesus and revealing Himself to the world. The holiday also marks the day the Magi, or the three kings, visited the baby Jesus in Bethlehem. Jesus' baptism is also celebrated during Epiphany.

Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect your love."

This short liturgy is a way of marking our homes, usually at the front or main entrance, with sacred signs and symbols as we ask God's blessing upon those who live, work, or visit throughout the coming year. In Exodus, the Israelites marked their doors with blood so that the Lord would pass over their homes; but in this service, we mark our doors with chalk as a sign that we have invited God's presence and blessing into our homes

The first and last numbers simply refer to the current year. The letters C M B come from the traditional names for the three kings: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. Some also suggest "Christus Mansionem Benedicat" which means, "May Christ bless this dwelling!

# KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS





#### FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF OUR LORD

On Monday, January 8, the Church celebrates the **Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord.** "When the Solemnity of the Epiphany is transferred to Sunday, if this Sunday occurs on January 7 or 8, the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is celebrated on the following Monday. This feast brings to an end the season of Christmas. Ordinary Time lasts from the day after

this feast to the Tuesday before Lent.

In the Eastern Church this feast is called *Theophany* because at the baptism of Christ in the River Jordan God appeared in three persons. The baptism of John was a sort of sacramental preparatory for the Baptism of Christ. It moved men to sentiments of repentance and induced them to confess their sins. Christ did not need the baptism of John. Although He appeared in the "substance of our flesh" and was recognized "outwardly like unto ourselves", He was absolutely sinless and impeccable. He conferred upon the water the power of the true Baptism which would remove all the sins of the world: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him Who takes away the sin of the world".

Many of the incidents which accompanied Christ's baptism are symbolical of what happens at our Baptism.

# UROCZYSTOŚĆ OBJAWIENIA PAŃSKIEGO

7 stycznia, 2024

"Wybaczajcie sobie nawzajem, jeśliby miał ktoś zarzut przeciw drugiemu:.

Jak Pan wybaczył wam, tak i wy!" (Kol 3, 13)



Wędrówka "mędrców ze Wschodu" jest drogą naszego poszukiwania i drogi wiary. Mędrcy przybywają do Jerozolimy, która jest obrazem Kościoła, jaśniejącej pięknem oblubienicy Boga. Tam, w Jerozolimie, próbują weryfikować swoje natchnienia i intuicje. My również w Kościele, który jest naszą Matką, nieustannie korygujemy nasze myśli i pragnienia. Dalej mędrcy udają się za przewodem gwiazdy do Betlejem (z hebr. Domu Chleba). Tam spotykają Świętą Rodzinę. Święta Rodzina jest wspólnotą, która jako pierwszą przyjmuje i poznaje niezgłębioną tajemnicę wcielenia. Również i my, wpatrując się we wzór Świętej Rodziny, uzyskujemy przystęp do tajemnicy mądrości i miłości Słowa Wcielonego. Odpowiedzią Monarchów na spotkanie z tajemnicą jest po-

kłon i złożenia darów: złota – dla Pana i Króla świata, mirry – cierpienia i męki, kadzidła – chwały i uwielbienia. Zatem już w tajemnicy wcielenia jesteśmy zanurzeni w misterium paschalne – męki i chwały, i uwielbienia.

#### TRADYCJA OZNACZANIA DRZWI

Umieszczany u nas najczęściej napis K+M+B 2024 odnosi się do imion trzech Mędrców ze Wschodu, którzy przybyli, aby oddać pokłon nowonarodzonemu Jezusowi (Kacper, Melchior i Baltazar). Jest to powszechnie przyjęty i poprawny zapis, jednak stoi za nim dość powierzchowna interpretacja. Znacznie starszy i głębszy przekaz mówi, że drzwi należy oznaczać napisem **C+M+B**, a do liter dopisać datę bieżącego roku: **C+M+B 2024**. W niektórych krajach skrót umieszcza się pomiędzy liczbami oznaczającymi rok: 20+C+M+B+24. Litery C+M+B to skrót pochodzący od łacińskiej sentencji Christus Mansionem Benedicat, która oznacza "(Niech) Chrystus mieszkanie błogosławi". Choć św. Augustyn podaje jeszcze jedną interpretację: *Christus-Multorum Benefaktor* – "Chrystus dobroczyńcą wielu". Łacińskie słowo mansio oznacza dom nie tylko w sensie samego zamieszkania, ale miejsce, w którym się pozostaje, czuje się osłoniętym, otulonym, miejsce życia i tworzenia wspólnoty. Dlatego, zgodnie z tradycją drzwi oznacza ojciec rodziny w obecności wszystkich domowników, wypowiadając słowa modlitwy:

#### Modlitwa przy oznaczaniu drzwi kreda

Panie Jezu Chryste, którego Trzej Mędrcy jako Dziecię znaleźli w domu i złożyli Mu hołd, który wzrastałeś w domu w Nazarecie przy boku Maryi i świętego Józefa, uświęć i nasz dom swoją obecnością. Niech panuje w nim Twoja miłość, dobroć i czystość. Niech wszyscy tworzymy domowy Kościół, który w tym sanktuarium niech stale składa Ci uwielbienie i chwałę. Niech święte symbole, które znaczymy na drzwiach tego domu, przypominają nam i tym, którzy będą nas odwiedzać, że jesteśmy domowym Kościołem i za gwiazdą wiary chcemy iść na spotkanie z Tobą, do domu naszego wspólnego Ojca, z którym w jedności Ducha Świętego żyjesz i królujesz przez wszystkie wieki wieków.

Pobłogosławiona kreda i kadzidło znajdują się przy żłóbku.

#### KORONKA DO MIŁOSIERDZIA BOŻEGO


