

Św. Andrzej Bobola – Patron Jedności

Św. Andrzej Bobola żył na przełomie XVI i XVII wieku, pochodził ze Strachociny, niewielkiej miejscowości w obecnym woj. podkarpackim (Polska). Polski duchowny katolicki, jezuita, misjonarz, kaznodzieja, męczennik. Był niezłomnym głosicielem Słowa Bożego. Do końca pozostał wierny Bogu, nie wyrzekając się wiary nawet pod groźbą śmierci. Jego beatyfikacja odbyła się w 1853 roku, natomiast do kanonizacji doszło w 1938 roku. Uznawany jest za patrona trudnych czasów, jedności religijnej protoplastę ekumenizmu. 16 maja 2002 roku został ogłoszony patronem Polski.
