Saint Joseph School Traditions: New and Old During Lent

According to the website buildfaith.org, the word "Lent" comes from the "Anglo-Saxon word lencton – meaning "spring" or "lengthening" from the time of year when the days grow long. Some believe "Lent" may derive from the Latin lentare, which means "to bend." This understanding reinforces Lent as a time of preparation for personal and collective transformation. Saint Joseph School students have nurtured themselves through Advent, Christmas, and Epiphany. Now, Lent becomes the time to reinforce the need to look truthfully at ourselves and consider making changes. Therefore, following Ash Wednesday Mass, our students gathered in the school to begin a new tradition: Burying the Alleluia.



Ms. Kelly Bailey's Fifth Grade students led the ceremony. They began by explaining that during the contemplative season of Lent, we do not speak or sing "Alleluias" because they are joyful proclamations. Instead, like a favorite toy we put away for a while to appreciate later, the school was burying the Alleluia. Then, Mrs. Boudreau showed the students a handmade wooden sign with the word Alleluia brightly painted on it. Following the reading of Psalm 112:1-7, a student leader proclaimed: "It's time to say goodbye to our friend, the Alleluia, to let it rest for a while so that it will return to us at Easter full of enthusiasm to remind us again who we are: loved children of God." Another student recited the prayer: "Lord God, our creator, as we bury this sign of heaven's song, help us to turn ourselves to living a good Lent. Help us to give up things that stand between us and your love and walk with Jesus on the road that leads us closer to you. We give up our Alleluia only for a while so that we may make more beautiful music in our hearts and lives when we sing it again at Easter. Amen." The wooden Alleluia was then sealed in a plastic bag and placed in a wooden crate, and every Saint Joseph School student placed a cup of dirt on top of the Alleluia. When the students finally buried the Alleluia, the Fifth Grade ended in prayer, saying, "Lord, we have given up for a time the song of heaven so that we may prepare our hearts and minds to be ready for heaven. Help us, in Jesus, to die to selfish habits that keep us from you and to live more fully with your peace and joy. Please help us to be renewed in your Spirit as we live this Lent. Amen."

The wooden crate containing the buried Alleluia is on display in the school's main hallway. The hand-painted crate has the word "Hope" displayed on the front. On Easter, there will be a celebration as the Alleluia is unburied. Students will plant lilies in the crate, and the brightly painted plaque with the word Alleluia on the front will be proudly displayed. We are very excited about this new tradition!



Another tradition that continues at Saint Joseph School during Lent is, "Good Deeds for Jesus." During Lent, Saint Joseph School students are encouraged to pray more, fast, and give alms to get closer to Jesus. They persevere in making loving sacrifices and doing good deeds. Then, each week, the students gather for a Lenten prayer service and are given a flower to represent the sacrifices and good deeds they want to offer to Jesus. The flowers are assembled into a beautiful cross included in the offertory at Family Mass on Sunday. It's a beautiful reminder of the students practicing the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy!

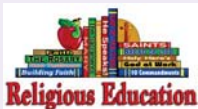
