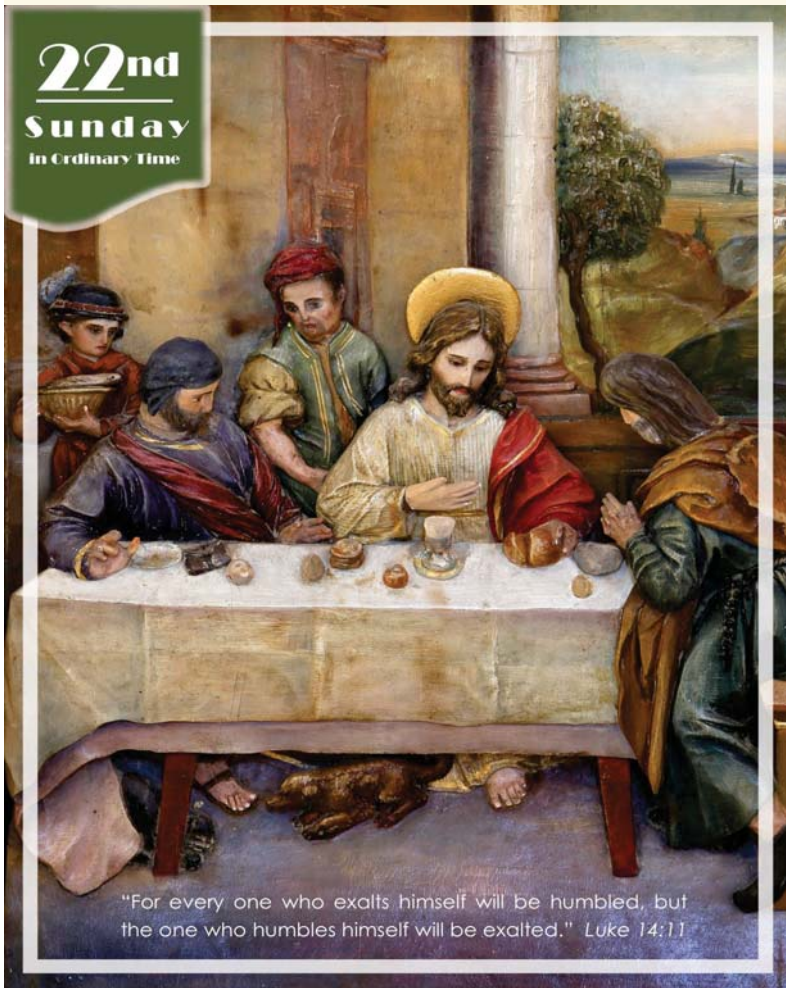

"Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; Blesses indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you." LUKE 14:13-14



After a volcano in Iceland interrupted air travel, several stranded passengers were interviewed as they waited for days to get out of the airport and on their way home. Some complained about poor service or how they were so badly inconvenienced. But one woman joked about her plight, making others laugh about being tired, stinky and less than ready to meet the queen! Her good humor made things a lot more bearable. Jesus reminds us that we are all equal before God and we should treat each other with dignity and respect. When people seek a higher place than we have, let them. When someone who has nothing to give wants to be included, allow him. If someone is poor or uneducated or socially awkward, include him. God sees all and rewards those who see Him in others. We have opportunities to practice this kind of virtue and humility every day. In the parking lot after

Mass, coming home from work, at the table with our family and talking to neighbors and friends are times when we can be more generous, more caring and more understanding of the needs of others. Try to listen a little more than you speak, give a little more than you get, offer a little more than you must. It will all come back to you in ways that you cannot measure.

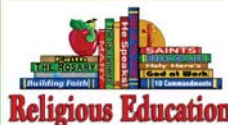
1-25 CLUB BANQUET

BACK TO SCHOOL AT SAINT JOSEPH SCHOOL A Joyful and Faith-Filled Start

On **Tuesday, August 26**, Saint Joseph School joyfully opened its doors to students in **Grades 1–8** for the start of the 2025–2026 academic year. As cars pulled up for morning drop-off, students were warmly welcomed by student members of the AAA Safety Patrol, faculty, staff, and the beloved school mascot, **JoJo**, setting the tone for a joyful and faith-filled return.

The first morning was spent in homerooms, where students reviewed classroom expectations, school-wide policies, and important safety protocols, including evacuation procedures and the **Technology Acceptable Use Policy**, which outlines appropriate use of school-issued devices and guidance on **Artificial Intelligence (AI)** tools. Students also revisited Saint Joseph School's **Bullying Prevention and Intervention Plan**, reinforcing the school's mission of *Religion, Respect, and Responsibility*.

This year, Saint Joseph School introduced a new **Cell Phone and Personal Device Policy** for students. In an effort to foster a calm, focused, and spiritually enriching environment, the school has implemented a **cell phone ban during school hours**. Numerous studies highlight how smartphones and social media hinder academic focus and student well-being. Limited exceptions to the policy are granted for medical needs, learning accommodations (IEP/504), accessibility tools, and students walking to school or commuting via school bus—however, all require a **Device Permit Form** signed by the principal. Approved devices must be turned off and stored securely during the school day.

The first day culminated in a lively, school-wide assembly. Eighth grade students were honored by Principal **Mrs. Beth Boudreau** and their homeroom teacher, **Mrs. Mary Ann Weaver**, as they celebrated their "**last first day**" at Saint Joseph School. Their younger peers welcomed them with cheers and music that had the whole school clapping along, while the eighth grade students received red beads from Mrs. Weaver. Mrs. Boudreau also introduced the entire **2025–2026 teaching staff**, followed by a dialogue with students about school policies and expectations. Middle School students were further recognized for successfully completing their summer academic assignments.

Later that evening, families of **Pre-K and Kindergarten students** attended an orientation night that began with a warm welcome from the principal. Parents then visited their children's classrooms, where teachers provided key information to ensure a successful start.

On **Wednesday, August 27**, the excitement continued as this year's Kindergarten class - now at capacity with 24 students - arrived for their first day of school. Led by classroom teacher **Mrs. Alicia Maurer** and teaching assistant **Mrs. Sandra Gibson**, the students stepped confidently into their new roles as Saint Joseph School Kindergarten students.

On **Thursday, August 28**, Saint Joseph School welcomed **full-time Pre-K 3-year-old students** as well as those in the **4-year-old Pre-K program**. Next week, students in the **2-day and 3-day 3-year-old programs** will also have their special first days of school.

To help families of older students stay informed, a **Parent Orientation Night** for families of **students in Grades 1–8** will be held on **Wednesday, September 3 at 6:00 p.m. in the school gymnasium**. This event will offer an overview of school expectations, curriculum updates, and a chance to meet teachers.

To mark the beginning of this exciting new year, **families, friends, and parishioners are warmly invited to our first Family Mass on Sunday, September 7 at 9:00 a.m.** During this celebration, **faculty and staff will be formally introduced to the parish community** and will publicly take their **Oath of Fidelity** as Catholic educators.

With a **15% increase in enrollment** this year, Saint Joseph School is filled with renewed energy, faith, and enthusiasm. We are blessed to welcome so many **returning families and new faces** into our school community and look forward to a year of growth, joy, and shared purpose.

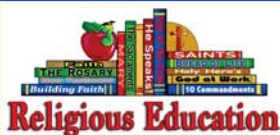
Łk 14, 14



Każdy z nas jest duchowo ubogi, ułomny, chromy i niewidomy. Możemy nie widzieć u siebie tych braków i ułomności, ale właśnie takimi jesteśmy. Objawia nam to sam Pan: *Ty bowiem mówisz: „Jestem bogaty”, i „wzbogaciłem się”, i „niczego mi nie potrzeba”, a nie wiesz, że to ty jesteś nieszczęśliwy i godzien litości, i biedny, i ślepy, i nagi* (por. Ap 3, 17). Bóg nas zaprosił do swego królestwa, choć – jak łotr na krzyżu (zob. Łk 23, 43) –

nie mamy czym Mu się odplacić. Ale w taki właśnie sposób szczęśliwy jest Bóg: bezinteresowna miłość, którą rozdaje każdemu bez wyjątku, to Jego szczęście. Bóg nas kocha i nie przestaje kochać, gdy nie odpowiadamy Mu z wzajemnością. Dziś On zaprasza nas do posmakowania już tu na ziemi Jego szczęścia poprzez gesty bezinteresownej miłości. Chce, abyśmy skosztowali prawdziwej radości, której doświadczamy wtedy, gdy obdarowujemy tych, o których wiemy, że nie będą w stanie nam się odwdziżyć. Wówczas również poznajemy, jak fałszywa jest „radość” proponowana przez świat, która nam wmawia, że szczęśliwi możemy być jedynie, dostając w zamian tyle samo, ile daliśmy.

Dziękujemy wszystkim, którzy pamiętają o ofiarach na rzecz naszej parafii, nawet podczas wyjazdów wakacyjnych. Bóg zapłać!

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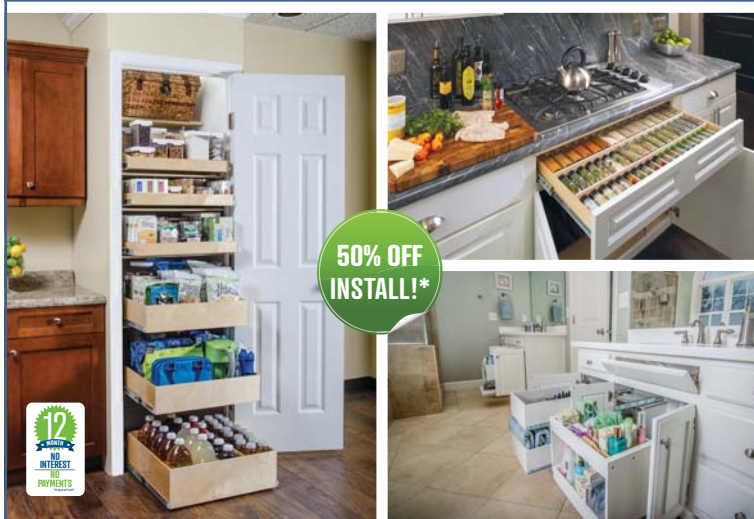


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
