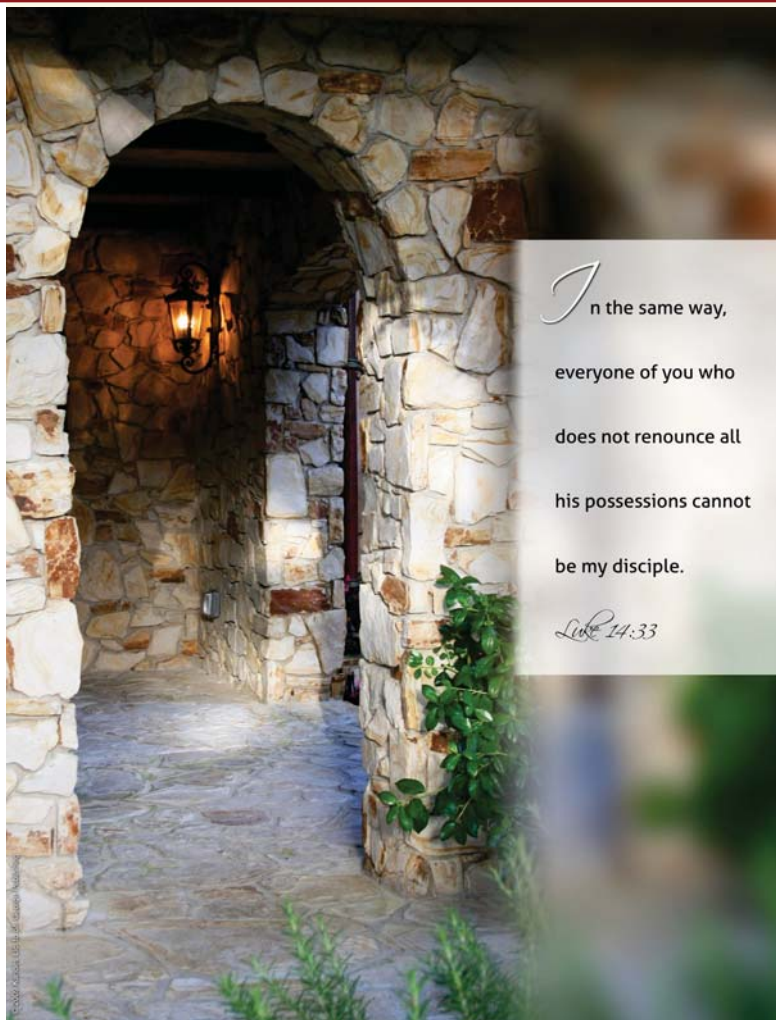

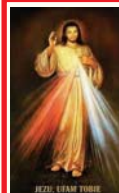

NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY FEAST DAY—SEPTEMBER 8



The details of Mary's birth are unknown. Her parents, not mentioned in the Bible, are called Joachim and Anne in the apocryphal Gospel of James. This book claims that Joachim went in to the desert to lament their childlessness and learned in a vision or dream that he and Anne would have a daughter. Ancient traditions put Mary's birth in Nazareth or Jerusalem. The feast of her birth originated in the East; in the seventh century, Pope St. Sergius I ordered that it and three other Marian feasts, the Annunciation, Purification and Assumption, be celebrated in Rome. This feast is another sign of God's faithfulness to old and new covenant promises that were fully realized in Mary's son, Jesus Christ.

Summer Learning with IXL at Saint Joseph School

At Saint Joseph School, we believe that learning should never stop—even when the school doors close for the summer. This year, students in Grades 5–8 were given the opportunity to keep their minds active and skills sharp by completing summer work through the online learning platform, IXL.

By engaging with IXL over the summer, our students experienced many benefits. Research shows that consistent practice helps prevent the "summer slide," a learning loss that can occur when students take a long break from academics. Instead, our middle school students returned to class this fall ready to build upon the knowledge they reinforced throughout the summer.

At Saint Joseph School, we integrate IXL into our curriculum year-round as a powerful tool to support student learning. The program personalizes practice for each child's needs, ensures skills are fully mastered before moving on, and provides teachers with detailed insights into student progress. By completing summer work with IXL, our

students demonstrated dedication, responsibility, and commitment to lifelong learning.

To celebrate their hard work, students were recognized at our **Kick-Off Assembly** on the first day of school. The final leaderboard for the summer was as follows:

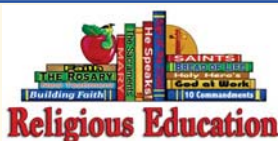

Wspólny posiłek lub kawa – To moment, by się lepiej poznać i poczuć się swobodnie.

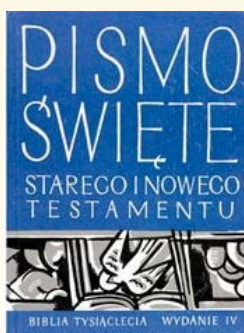

W poniedziałek, 8 września świętujemy Narodzenie Najświętszej Maryi Panny. Maryja odgrywa niezwykle rolę w historii zbawienia, a Jej narodziny zapowiadają przyjście Zbawiciela, Jezusa Chrystusa. W tym szczególnym dniu pragniemy uhonorować Maryję, wpatrując się w Jej niezwykłą wiarę, pokorę i oddanie Bogu. Jej życie jest dla nas wzorem zaufania i posłuszeństwa, a także przypomnieniem, że każdy z nas ma swoje powołanie i misję w planie Bożym. Niech nasze błagania i dziękczynienie będą wyrazem miłości do Matki Bożej oraz świadectwem wiary w Bożą obecność wśród nas.

W Polsce święto Narodzenia Najświętszej Maryi Panny ma także nazwę Matki Bożej Siewnej. Był bowiem dawny zwyczaj, że dopiero po tym święcie i uprzątnięciu pól zaczynało orkę i siew.

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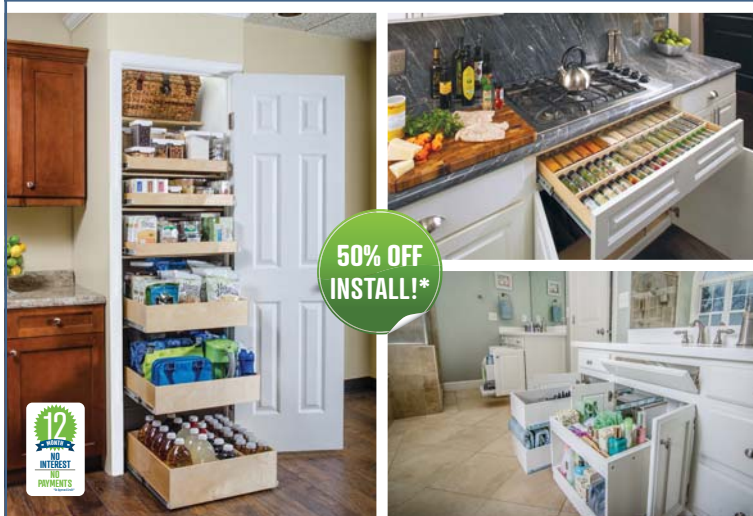


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
