*"...because I came down from heaven not to do my own will but the will of the one who sent me...."  
JOHN 6:38*



A student wrote an essay about the person he most admired and he chose his grandfather, although he had never met him. His grandfather had struggled to raise not only his family, but also the families of two of his army buddies who had died in World War I. The sacrifices and efforts of his grandfather made a big difference in the lives of 13 children, all of whom considered him to be their dad. It was an inspiring story that made the student want to help others and emulate his hero.

The Feast of All Souls recalls the stories of those who have gone before us in faith. Often it was their prayers, sacrifices and hard work that established our parishes, built our schools and moved our faith into the mainstream of American life. Many are unnamed and unknown, but nonetheless their contributions made a difference. Their witness feeds our faith, handing on the Gospel from one generation to the next.

When you pray for the Holy Souls today, offer a prayer of thanks for them. Ask the Lord to grant them eternal life and peace. But also honor their work and their memory by taking your turn and doing your part for those who will follow you.

**INDULGENCES FOR THE DEAD**

An indulgence is "the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned." To obtain this remission there are proper dispositions and certain conditions predetermined by the Church that must be met by the faithful. To gain an indulgence for the dead, one should visit the cemetery and pray for the deceased, at the least. You must also fulfill the **usual terms** of: state of sanctifying grace (or Confession if needed), Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father. In addition, to obtain an indulgence it is necessary to rid ourselves of the attachment to any sin, even venial sin.

**This indulgence, between the days of November 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> is plenary** (entirely freed from the punishment of sin) whereas on the other days of the year the indulgence is partial.

We encourage everyone to use these opportunities to help our deceased. Our sacrifices for the deceased is an expression of our faith in the **Communion of Saints**, the extraordinary exchange of spiritual gifts between the pilgrim Church on earth, the cleansing Church in Purgatory, and the glorious Church in Heaven.

## Wspomnienie Wszystkich Wiernych Zmarłych (DZIEŃ ZADUSZNY)

2 listopada, 2025

“Dlaczego szukacie żyjącego wśród umarłych? Nie ma Go tutaj; zmartwychwstał” Łk 24, 5-6



Wydaje się, że w godzinę śmierci Jezusa wielu z Jego bliskich Go opuściło, ale dzisiejszy fragment przypomina nam także, że wielu do końca trwało przy Nim, a także po Jego śmierci. Nawet ci, którzy do tej pory pozostawali gdzieś z boku, niewidoczni, zatruwani – jak Nikodem – teraz z odwagą idą do Piłata, aby prosić o ciało Jezusa. Śmierć Jezusa na krzyżu, tak pokorna i cicha, przemienia serca ludzi i prowadzi ich do przemiany. Kobiety kierowane miłością i przywiązaniem do swego Mistrza i Pana idą do grobu, aby namaścić Jego ciało wonnościami. My także udajemy się na groby tych, którzy odeszli, których kochamy, za którymi tęsknimy. Jest to ważne i potrzebne. Jeszcze ważniejsze jest, abyśmy uświadomili sobie, że także płyty z ich grobów są odsunięte, a oni są w drodze lub już u celu, w innym, lepszym świetle. Nasza modlitwa służy naszym bliskim zmarłym, pomaga w drodze do Ojca i pozwala na nowy sposób relacji i bycia z nimi.

### WSPOMNIENIE WSZYSTKICH WIERNYCH ZMARŁYCH

Wspomnienie Wszystkich Wiernych Zmarłych Kościoł obchodzi 2 listopada i w tradycji polskiej dzień ten jest nazywany Dniem Zadusznym lub inaczej "zaduszkami". Kościół w tym dniu wspomina zmarłych pokutujących za grzechy w czyśćcu. Chodzi więc o których nie mogą wejść do nieba, gdyż mają pewne długi do spłacenia Bożej sprawiedliwości. Cała wspólnota Kościoła przychodzi z pomocą duszom czyścącym zanosząc w tym dniu prośby przed tron Boży.



### WYPOMINKI

W niedzielę, 2 listopada, przed każdą Mszą św. będziemy wspominać naszych zmarłych, polecając ich Miłosierdziu Bożemu. Podobnie podczas Różańca za zmarłych w Poniedziałek, Wtorek, Środę i Czwartek o godz. **6:30 pm**.

### PROCESJA NA CMENTARZU

W niedzielę, **2 listopada o godzinie 14:00** zapraszamy wszystkich parafian i przyjaciół do udziału w nabożeństwie za zmarłych i procesji na naszym Cmentarzu Parafialnym. Procesja rozpocznie się przy krzyżu, gdzie również będzie możliwość nabycia zniczy.

### ODPUSTY ZA ZMARŁYCH

Z Dniem Zadusznym wiąże się możliwość uzyskania odpustów, czyli łaski darowania całkowitego lub częściowego kary za popełnione grzechy.

Aby zyskać odpust za zmarłych należy nawiedzić cmentarz i przynajmniej w myśli pomodlić się w intencji zmarłych. Należy także wypełnić tzw. **warunki zwykle**: stan łaski uświęcającej, Komunia święta, modlitwa w intencjach Ojca Świętego. Ponadto do uzyskania odpustu konieczne jest wyzbycie się przywiązania do jakiegokolwiek grzechu, również lekkiego.

**Odpust ten, w dniach 1-8 listopada jest zupełny** (całkowicie uwalnia od kary doczesnej za grzechy), w pozostałe dni roku jest częściowy. Jeżeli brak jest wspomnianej dyspozycji lub któregoś z warunków, odpust będzie częściowy.

Zachęcamy wszystkich do korzystania z tych możliwości pomocy naszym zmarłym. Nasza pomoc zmarłym jest wyrazem naszej wiary w Świętych Obcowanie, czyli w tę niezwykłą wymianę darów duchowych między Kościołem pielgrzymującym na ziemi, Kościołem oczyszczającym się w czyśćcu i Kościołem chwalebny w niebie.

**RÓŻANIEC ZA ZMARŁYCH:** W poniedziałek, wtorek, środę i czwartek zapraszamy na **Różaniec za zmarłych z wypominkami** i możliwością przyjęcia Komunii Świętej o godz. **6:30 wieczorem**.
