The commercial kitchen will be constructed adjacent to the Parish Hall to prepare lunch for Trinity students and serve large parish gatherings. The existing kitchen will remain.

# **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE**

The IB MYP educational experience sets the standard for students to take responsibility for their own learning. IB MYP students go beyond the traditional "paper and pencil" test.

In preparation for the challenges and requirements of higher learning and faithful citizenship, students are required to validate answers and defend positions. In a real world setting, students must apply new skills, **independently creating a product or performance**.

- MYP enrollment is shown to increase college-readiness by 39%.
- 8th Graders averaged 3.1 years above grade level on the Nationally Standardized Terra Nova Achievement Test.
- 42% of 8th Graders earned the President's Education Award for Academic Excellence, versus 3% nationally, earning a 3.5 or higher GPA and an 85% or higher score on the Terra Nova Test.
