
# **Building Project Update**


- You determine the amounts and when a donation is to be deducted; no delays for cash or checks to be deposited?

#### Knights of Columbus Assist Catholic Charities

Members of 3 Knights of Columbus Councils recently assisted Catholic Charities of Northwest Florida in receiving, unloading, and prioritizing a truckload of donated items from Matthew 25 Ministries via Food for the Poor. 


