Did you know... Donations you take from your IRA are normally treated as taxable income for you. However, if you are 70-1/2 years old or older, you may avoid the income tax on direct distributions you make to the campaign. These types of distributions, Qualified Charitable Contributions (QCDs), may be made up to \$100,000 annually. QCDs also count toward any required minimum distributions you must make in accordance with IRS regulations. - 2. Click on the "online giving" button.
- On upper right select "Log In" (to access existing account) or "Sign Up" to create a new account. Your email address
 will be your user name. If signing up, a profile will need to be completed. But if login in, no need to recreate
 profile every time.
- 4. Select donation fund(s), and frequency and amount for each.



- 5. Select "Basket" button.
- 6. Proceed to add payment type information. NOTE: there is option to NOT save your payment type information once transaction is completed.
