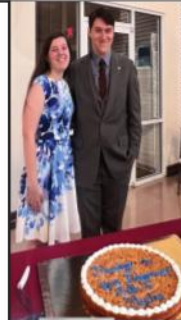

TCS Participation Voucher Reminder: If you have children who are attending Trinity Catholic School, please contact the office for a participation scholarship.

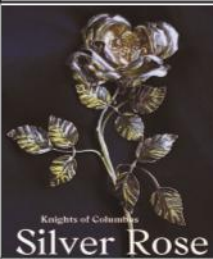
