Building Project News

We are closing in on a significant building project milestone: 90% construction documents. These will include all the plans and specifications for phase 1. Once finished, we will review the plans with the architects, engineers, and construction manager. This will be followed by pre-permitting meetings with the city before submission to the city for permitting. While this set should closely represent the final phase 1, modifications could be required for permitting or code considerations. 
