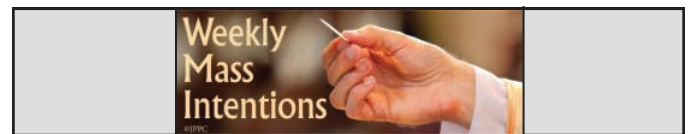

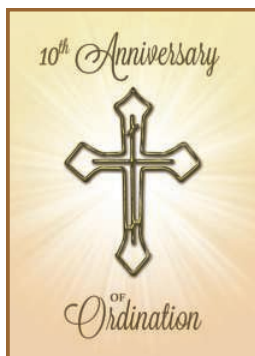

- Telehealth options, as well as convenient locations throughout the NY Archdiocese.

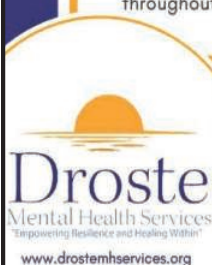
