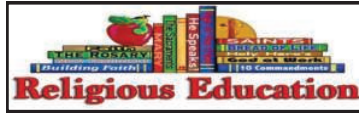

CLARE'S COVE THRIFT SHOP ~ A PARISH 'BOUTIQUE' AT ST. FRANCIS



This Fall, Clare's Cove Thrift Shop, right here at St. Francis in Rader Hall, begins its 30th year. From humble beginnings as a parish yard sale in 1995, dedicated volunteers, with the blessing of Father Dennis Fernandes, established a permanent home for a 'second hand' shop named Clare's Cove. (St. Clare was a first follower of St. Francis of Assisi) This hidden gem, has its own entrance located off our parking lot. The mission of 'The Cove', as the shop is affectionately called, is to provide the community with quality clothes and household items at reasonable prices. The store is stocked with a variety of items, including home goods, seasonal decor, books, handbags, quality clothing often with new tags and much more! Items are well organized with new donations arriving weekly. All proceeds from the store are given to the parish to assist in community services.

The Cove also supplies Birthright with baby items and clothes. It supports Catholic Community Services and Social Services. Donations are given to the homeless, One to One Learning, Care Net, new immigrant families, Veterans, and others. The thrift shop is staffed by a dedicated group of volunteers affectionately known as the "Covettes". Our 'little boutique' in West Nyack is a fun experience for 'thrifters', shoppers and friends, to come in, find treasures or just say hello. Clare's Cove is always grateful for the generous donations received from parishioners and non-parishioners.

The Shop reopens after the summer break on Thursday, September 4th.

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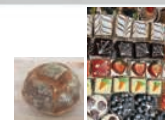
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
