



# A note from Father Tom

"[Jesus] said to them, 'These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and

psalms must be fulfilled.' Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, 'Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

Luke 24: 44-48

"You are witnesses of these things ..." <u>We</u> are witnesses of these things! This is so in a way different from the way in which those first disciples would be witnesses, of course. Jesus does not sit among us and eat a piece of baked fish in front of us. We are called and inspired to be witnesses who see and hear, who are caught up into and who give our own energy to the full life of witness of the Church, the Living Body of Christ.

This life we share is quite varied, from person to person and from moment to moment. Some of what we do because of who we are is rich in its beauty, some is daunting in its challenges. We try to live lives that have the strength and integrity to teach our children. We extend ourselves to care for the sick and our frail elderly. We reach out to touch the needs of mind, body and spirit of those whose needs become our own.

I want to acknowledge and thank all who have contributed to date to exceed the goal determined for us as a parish for *Partners in Charity*. Though our goal has been met, there remains an opportunity for some to participate in this year's campaign to meet the great needs addressed by ministries of the Diocese. As I write today, there is a fairly unglamorous project underway to restore the connection between our church building and the town sewer system on School Street. We also have had to do work on the lighting system in the church, the heating system in the parish center, and we have tackled long-delayed repairs and upgrades of the lock-and-key configuration for all three buildings!


