
Congratulations to Tommy our newest altar server!

Today's note for you would be easier if I were capable of time travel! Between this time in which I am writing and

the time in which you will be reading, life in our Parish will include:

The Annual Mass of Remembrance

I feel a little like Zacchaeus in this weekend's Gospel. He knows what he wants and hopes to see ... Jesus, as he approaches. So he positions himself the best place and way he knows how to compensate for his limited height. He climbs a tree, where he hopes to see, and more than that, he is seen by the One he seeks! The onlookers who hear Jesus call him down and hear him invite himself to Zacchaeus' house figure Jesus must be limited or confused by the distance away and the distance up and down. He's a notorious sinner after all!

Rather than climbing up today I am looking back. I am remembering what it has been like to look to Jesus with you by contemplating the joy of All the Saints.
