A Note from Father Tom

Psalm 23:1

The image of Christ as Shepherd is familiar to us. The title of Christ as the Good Shepherd also is familiar. The Lord's own declaration that he is not only shepherd but also the gate for the sheep takes more effort on our part to truly hear. He not only walks ahead of us or behind us to ensure our way and to be our safety. He IS the way by which and through which we enter and leave. He is the way of our true journey, the way of arrival to which and for which we are born.

There is much in life that vies for our attention. There are things, experiences, and even people who give us cause to think too little of ourselves or too much of ourselves. 2020 Partners in Charity Appeal


