

A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

A simple definition of prayer is conversation with God. Through prayer, we speak, with our minds, hearts and souls, to our Creator, presenting to Him our love, thanksgiving, praise and needs. Prayer is an essential part of our Christian lives. Imagine being close to someone but never speaking with them. Indeed, without communication, our closeness and relationship would not last long. The same is true in our lives of faith. When we pray, we stay connected with God and He with us. Our friendship remains solid and relevant. Without prayer, we become distant and our friendship grows apart.

We pray individually and as a community of faith.

Mass is the greatest prayer. At it, we come together to worship God and join our prayers with those of the parish and whole Church. 
