A Note From Father Michael

Dear Friends in Christ,

As the Church enters the month of May, several Sacraments are often celebrated during this time which deserve our attention. These are Confirmation, Holy Orders and First Communion.

This Saturday, May 11, at the Cathedral, five of our parish young people received The Sacrament of Confirmation with other youth from Blackstone Valley parishes. At the rehearsal for Confirmation, held on Sunday, May 5, I suggested to these young people that Confirmation is "spiritual weight lifting." People lift weights to train themselves in the discipline of health and to become physically stronger. Confirmation completes Baptism and the grace it gives us strengthens us to bear witness to Christ in the world. We pray for our recently Confirmed young people that the strength the Sacrament has given them keep with them firm in faith and inspired by the Holy Spirit to always remain actively engaged in the life of the Church.

Next Saturday, May 18, also at the Cathedral, our deacon-intern, John, will receive the Sacrament of Holy Orders. His ordination to the permanent diaconate will make him a member of the clergy of our Diocese of Worcester. The Catechism of The Catholic Church explains that Holy Orders is "the Sacrament of Apostolic ministry by which the mission entrusted by Christ to His Apostles continues to be exercised in the Church through the laying on of hands." The Catechism also explains that Holy Orders has "three distinct degrees...deacon, priest and bishop. All three confer a permanent, sacramental character." I hope that many of us will attend John's ordination to show him our support and gratitude and to express our parish's gratefulness for his presence with

As we celebrate Mother's Day this Sunday, our thoughts turn to Mary, the Mother of Christians. As our Mother, Our Lady loves us and wants our best, especially that we grow daily in love of God and neighbor. As we celebrate Mother's Day, perhaps we can offer Our Lady a Rosary expressing to her our love and devotion. We ask that she continue to pray for us, our families and parish, and that always we remain under her heavenly protection. May all mothers of our parish be especially blessed by Our Lady's care for them.


